# New Legal Requirements

(Effective 4/1/2019)

As of April 1, 2019, there will be a major change to the current laws dealing with the lawful carry of concealed firearms. Current CCW holders must apply for a new permit known as the Conceal Carry Ammunition permit or CCA. As of April 1, 2019, your CCW will allow you to carry an unloaded concealed weapon. You will not be allowed to be in possession of any ammunition, on your person. This is seen as an extension to the laws that will be going into effect in July that states that you will have to get a background check each time that you purchase ammunition.

As of April 1st, 2019, all current CCW holders must apply for the permit that will allow them to carry ammunition in their concealed carry weapons. All future CCW applicants will have to apply for both the CCW and the new CCA. The waiting period for these new permits is estimated at being at least 4 months and possibly longer. The New CCA will allow you to carry up to 10 rounds of ammunition for the firearm that you are carrying. There will be another fee for a CCA enhancement that will allow you to carry a second magazine of ammunition for the same firearm. However, the new CCA will have stricter rules governing who will be allowed to carry concealed ammunition. The new background check will incorporate a review

of all records going back to elementary school. If the applicant was ever disciplined for talking in class or not doing their homework, their application could be denied. Additionally, if the applicant was ever found guilty of an infraction in which the teacher or principal could have imposed a sentence of "standing in the corner" or "missing a recess", that applicant will immediately be denied their CCA and will be report to the local school board for further corrective action.

Subsequently, the applicant will have to attend a 12-hour class on how to safely handle the ammunition. Topics covered will include how to care for your ammunition, ammunition equality, ammunition privilege and how to load and discharge your ammunition without offending others. The final test will be much like the Twelve Labors of Hercules, each task being more daunting then the last. Few are expected to pass, unscathed.

## NIDPA Update

For the fellow members of our association, I'd like to take this opportunity to introduce you to the NIDPA match and what it's about. NIDPA stands for New Instructional Defensive Pistol Action. During NIDPA matches members are able to work on their defensive pistol deployment, accuracy and speed, while simultaneously enjoying a little friendly competition. This prepares members for action shooting sports like IDPA and USPSA.

### What do you need:

- The cost for this match is \$0.00, yup that's right something for nothing.
- EF&GA membership
- Shooters must have some Pistol and Holster Experience
- All shooters must be pre-qualified prior to participation in the event. Contact the shoot chair for arrangements.
- Concealable pistol with iron sights.
- Strong side holster, no drop leg holsters (unless you're LE or active MIL and use it as a duty rig).
- Magazine or speed loader carrier for at least two magazines or speed loaders.
- Approximately 100 rounds of ammunition.

### Participants

There will be several (four to six) courses of fire requiring the shooter to do different things and solve the problem in front of them, there will likely be many ways to do it. In this sanctioned match rapid fire will be allowed and in many cases double taps or repetitive hits necessary. Most stages will have targets anywhere from one yard to ten yards away.

The match is held on the second Saturday of the month on the trap range. There will be a mandatory safety brief at 0800 to address safety rules and describe the COF (course of fire) for each stage. Shooters will break into groups and begin the COF on each stage, then calling the range COLD for each stage and confirming with the other stages that the range is COLD and then go down range for scoring, taping the holes, and recording the shooters times.

I look forward to seeing members out for this match once again and hope to continue on the path set by Norm to train, teach, and entertain the members.

# JUNIOR CORNER

As everyone should know, the Junior Marksmanship Program as well as the entire Escondido Fish and Game Association is dedicated to safety. This includes the constant safety briefs and reciting our "Rules to Live by" every chance we get. We do everything that we can to be proactive in our approach to safety. In addition, we try to be ready if, God forbid, we do have an accident on the range, whether it be a snake bite, a broken bone, or whatever, we all hope to be ready to render immediate first aid, as necessary. This commitment to safety means that many of the Junior Marksmanship Shoot Chairs and people that are closely associated with the program, continually attend different types of training. The last training was done this past weekend at the 5.11 store in Oceanside. The class was called "Stop the Bleed". The class covered topics such as how to quickly assess a situation and apply a tourniquet or pack the wound in order to stop the bleeding and stabilize the person until EMS arrives. This is a vital skill to have as EMS could be minutes away when seconds could mean the difference between life and death. We would like to thank 5.11 for putting on the training and to everyone at EF&GA that attended. Additionally, we will be setting up these classes at EF&GA, soon.

Talking about commitment to the Junior program, we added up all the hours that our Junior Coaches put into the program at the range last year. In 2018, our 15 current Junior Coaches put in more than 550 hours of volunteer time. That's an average of over 36 hours each. Some of our rock stars include Kestrin "The Hurricane" Walsh (105 hrs), AJ Wagle (66.55 hrs), Daysha Halbert (63.15 hrs), Austin Cote (62.05 hrs), and Michelle Fan (52.1 hrs). These young adults show up to range clean ups, small working parties, and they come up to help with other programs, including doing safety briefs for adult classes. All these coaches appreciate what the range has done for them and they are happy to return the favor. If you ever wondered what a future leader looks like, look no further than the Junior Coaches Program. This is what our future leaders look like.

Continuing with our look at commitment to the Junior Program, I would like to thank RDL Tactical in Escondido. Rick and his son Tanner recently finished refurbishing all the pistols that are used for the Junior Program and Women on Target. They completely stripped down all the pistols and basically replaced or fixed any worn out or broken parts and did a deep cleaning. This took a lot of time and energy. The work was outstanding, plus, they did it in a very timely manner and the price, per firearm, was extremely low. When you get a chance, go tell Rick and Tanner thanks for taking care of our Junior Program and making sure that the firearms are in the best shape possible.

## RULES TO LIVE BY

1. **Treat** every firearm as if it were loaded
2. **Never** point your firearm at anything you don't intend to shoot
3. **Keep** your finger straight and off the trigger until you intend to fire
4. **Know** your target and the surroundings

In our busy and stressful lives we may not take the time to ponder these great mysteries of life -

1. If a tree falls in the forest and no one is around to see or hear it, does it make a sound?
2. If I am the only one on the range and I don't follow our safety rules, does it make a difference?
3. If I am Special (competitor, RSO, law enforcement, military, cranky-old-man) and know what I am doing, does it make a difference?

The answer to the first question I will leave to the philosophers. The answer to the second and third questions are a big fat YES!

We do expect you to follow the normal Hot/Cold procedures, targets and target placement, appropriate firearm for the range and rapid fire at all times even, if you are the only one on the range.

We have had incidents were there was someone down range who did not feel the need to go Cold (only one on the range) and another shooter arrived, comes on the line with equipment since the range was Hot! The person down range got upset... Sigh -

If you disagree with a particular rule(s) let me know and I would be happy to discuss it with you.

It has been mentioned many times that everyone is a Range Safety Officer regardless if they have a Red Hat.

Well, it is starting to work. I have gotten several emails with members asking for rule clarifications and notifying me of potential safety violations. Important information to collect is Date/Time, Names if possible (you do not need to confront anyone), Pictures (Green sheet for names), Videos, License plates and details on what has happened.

Just to be clear to everyone, the EFG&A Range Safety rules apply to members, guests, the public and especially to the Range Safety Officers (Red Hats).

As the Chief RSO I expect that the Red Hat Range Safety Officers (regardless if they are just a member or club officer) will act in a courteous and professional manner when dealing with range activities.

We should all know that there is a green sign in/out sheet at each range and it should be dated with the current date. If the sheet is from a previous day, please place a new sheet on top and date appropriately. We collect the previous days sheets which go into the plastic RSO bin in the club house for later review.

Please remember if you will be attending the annual picnic to bring safety glasses and ear protection for everyone in your party.

**Members Only** are allowed to submit Classified advertisements. Your Membership Number must be included with any advertisement request so that we can properly vet the submission before it is published. The Membership Number will NOT appear in the advertisement. Your Membership Number is on your membership badge on the same side as your photo.

**No Illegal Transactions** may be advertised in this newsletter. It is now illegal to sell ammunition in California without either going through an FFL or a licensed ammunition reseller. EF&GA cannot facilitate any illegal commerce of a state regulated commodity. This is also why firearm sales should include a phrase similar to Buyer pays DROS when advertising the sale of a firearm.

It may sound obvious but requests for classifieds are frequently received with not enough information to be useful to a reader. **There are 5 main components of a classified ad:**

**Category** – Most classifieds fall into one of 3 categories, 'For Sale', 'Wanted', or 'Lost & Found'.

**Subject/Title** – This will appear in bold in the advertisement. This should be short (2 or 3 words) and concise.

**Description** – This is the body of the advertisement and can be a few sentences but not more than a paragraph. Abbreviations appear cryptic and are not recommended unless they are well known acronyms.

**Price** – A specific dollar amount as well as qualifiers give the reader important information. For example, "\$600 or Best Offer, Buyer pays DROS, Will consider trades"

**Contact Info** – This should be a name AND a phone number (including area code) and/or an e-mail address.

# BLACK POWDER NEWS

## 40 Years of Black Powder Silhouette

Coming up at the April 28th contest, is our 40th Anniversary of the Black Powder Silhouette shoot. For the April contest we will offer a special "Walk Through" shoot for both Pistol and Rifle at "Unknown" distances. Targets will range from 25 to 75 yards for pistol, and 25 to 125 yards for rifle. There will be nine gong targets for each course. The rifle course will have free standing silhouettes at the 150 yard line to act as tie-breakers. Scoring will be our standard two points for a first round hit, or one point if you have to shoot twice to hit the target. (This preserves our ongoing 6 month Black Diamond rifle challenge scoring system.) First Place 40th anniversary medallions will be awarded for each of five categories to include Single Shot Pistol, Cap & Ball Revolver, Open Rifle, Primitive Rifle, and Black Powder Cartridge Rifle. The single shooter that has the highest combined pistol and rifle score will win a **MASSIVE** 40th Anniversary Trophy. Subject to class restrictions, loading can be done from the bench or in the field, (We are NOT shooting from the range house.) Standard restrictions will be in effect on not capping or priming until you step to the designated firing line.

To run this contest I need 5 to 7 volunteers, (of questionable moral character), to call shots and hits on the firing line. No heavy lifting is required. 
