Darrin's Dissertation

AB 2571

The State Assembly passed AB 2571 and put it on the Governor's desk for signature on June 30th, 2022. Because it includes an *Emergency Clause*, it went into effect July 1st, 2022. This bill makes it illegal to <u>advertise</u> any firearms, parts, ammunition, apparel, and activities from any *firearms industry member* directed to minors in the State of California. Penalties for each violation are fines up to \$25000 per violation. As it is written, EF&GA would likely be considered a *firearms industry member*. As a result, we have removed all advertising of any Junior Marksmanship events pending further advice from our attorney and any changes to the implementation and enforcement of the law.

First of all, Escondido Fish & Game Association is NOT a political organization and is NOT affiliated with any political party or politician. Individual members are free to have their individual opinions, but the Association has no official political positions. With that in mind, it is obvious that AB 2571 conflicts with our stated mission:

The objectives of Escondido Fish & Game Association are to promote conservation of our fish and game, to cooperate with the responsible fish & game government agencies, to promote fellowship among sportsmen and landowners, to promote the shooting sports, to serve the community by providing training such as hunter education and firearm safety, and to assist youth organizations in their firearms training.

Our Junior Marksmanship Program has grown over the years and we are hoping to continue with that tradition. We are not sure if we need to cease the events or just the advertising. While we cannot *advertise* the events, you are certainly able to directly contact the shoot chair of any event for current information about their respective events. Stay tuned for additional information as it becomes available.

In other Association news, we have a new Maintenance Person, **Dean Dorman**. This stellar individual has been an active EF&GA member and shoot chair for many years and has a background in automotive mechanics. Please make him feel welcome to his new position with the Association. If you are looking for a good way to get volunteer hours completed, Dean has a long list of tasks and he is always looking for additional bodies to help get those items completed.

NRA Metallic Cartridge Reloading Class 8/6/2022, 9/24/2022 & 11/5/2022

Class Description:

This class will supply you with the knowledge of how to properly and safely reload your used casings into economical, effective and accurate ammunition.

The class is structured in two separate sessions:

1st session – This ½ of the class is academic and is held in the EF&GA Meeting Hall on the above dates from 8am until noon. 2nd session – This ½ of the class is "Hands On" training scheduled with a mutually agreed upon time and date where you will reload your own cartridges on the reloading bench.

The cost of the class is \$125 for EF&GA members and \$135 for non-members. If you need supplies (ie: cases, primers, projectiles and powder) they are available for a \$15 surcharge.

Prior registration is necessary and a \$20 deposit is required to secure a place in this limited class.

Class Description:

The Hunter Education Course is a nationally approved curriculum designed to teach hunters the knowledge, skills, and ethics to become safe and responsible hunters. The covered topics include basic firearms nomenclature, safe firearm loading/unloading practices, wildlife conservation, wildlife identification, hunting ethics, hunt preparations, hunting techniques, shot placement, bag limits, tracking skills, basic survival skills, basic navigation skills, basic first aid, game recovery, field dressing, game care and much more.

Every state in America requires a Hunter Education certificate in order to obtain a hunting license. The certificate issued is valid in all states and in numerous foreign countries, and is good for life. No live fire involved, firearms and ammunition are not required for the course.








Class Description:

The guest said he was with a member that was shooting the Cowboy Action Match on the 150 yard rifle range. He was advised that for Casual Shooting you cannot shoot from downrange. He was asked for the member's name, but would not give that information. Members, if you bring guests with you to the range, they must be with you at all times except when using the restrooms.

Casual shooting is not allowed in front of the (Red) firing line on any range.

The Green Sheets: If you sign any of the Green Sheets and there is not a Date and Range filled in, can you fill in the Date and Range? There are Green Sheets being turned in with no Date and Range information filled in.

All Shooters: Remove your targets from the target backers and return the target frames back to the designated area.

Make sure that what you bring with you to the range, you also take back home with you. There are still items, including rifles, being left at the range.

TOP GUN August 28th: August will be our annual TOP GUN competition for the year. After each frame we will go cold to reset and you then move to the next frame. Ties will be resolved by who got the most hits at the farthest distances. If you win this contest you are automatically promoted to Master Class. 

AROUND THE RANGE



Air Pistol Silhouette is Back

by Jim McKim

Air Pistol Silhouette returns to the event calendar in August. Held at 7 PM in the meeting hall on the 2nd Tuesday of the month, air pistol silhouette is a 40-round match shooting at small steel animals at distances of 10 to 18 yards. If you knock the target off the rack, it is a score for one point- very simple!

The challenge comes from the size of the targets, ranging from about that of a quarter coin for chickens at 10 yds to about the size of a baseball for rams at 18 yds. The good news is that, unlike in hunting, it doesn't matter if you hit them in the vitals or in a leg, neck or nose- as long as it falls over it counts as a hit!

Equipment requirements are simple: any air pistol in either .177 or .22 caliber is allowed. For "Air Pistol" category, any sights are allowed; for "Air Pistol Open Sights" only open or hunting-style peep sights ("irons") are allowed. Two matches will be held if shooters want to shoot in both categories. Eye protection is required.

EF&GA owns three nice air pistols that are available on loan for free to shoot the match. Shooters can either bring their own .177 ammo or pay \$1 per match for ammo. (Contact the Shoot Chair in advance if you want to shoot a loaner.) 

.22s.....Again???

The other day I did a little experiment using one box of lower end Eley ammunition. The process was time consuming but it gleaned a lot of information about the rifle and the ammunition.

I measured the headspace of each round in the box and separated them into groups. Amazingly, I was able to detect four separate dimensions out of the same box. The next step was to go to the range and check the differences, if any, that the headspace had to do with consistency and accuracy.

The results were eye opening. With four targets on the backboard and the stand at 50 yds, I fired 5 rounds at each target. The numbers (#) are indicative of the tool index I used. As you can see in the photo, there is a lot of discrepancy. It definitely shows that headspace plays a large role in .22 accuracy. My rifle, a Mossberg 144LSB, isn't especially fond of this ammo. It gives me mediocre results. That was until I did this test.

So, were I to use this box of ammunition for precision shooting, my points of impact could vary anywhere from lower left to center right at any given shot.

For me the solution is to check my ammo, whichever brand I'm using, to recognize the headspaces included. The basic key, though, is to use the ammo that performs best with your rifle. .22 shooting is no less precise than centerfire, possibly, even more so.
