Hunter Education Class 8/12/2023 (7 am - 4 pm)

Class Description:

The Hunter Education Course is a nationally approved curriculum designed to teach hunters the knowledge, skills and ethics to become safe and responsible hunters. The covered topics include basic firearms nomenclature, safe firearm loading/unloading practices, wildlife conservation, wildlife identification, hunting ethics, hunt preparations, hunting techniques, shot placement, bag limits, tracking skills, basic survival skills, basic navigation skills, basic first aid, game recovery, field dressing, game care and much more. Every state in America requires a Hunter Education Certificate in order to obtain a hunting license. The certificate issued is valid in all states and in numerous foreign countries, and is good for life. No live fire involved, firearms and ammunition are not required for the course.

Bow Hunter Education Class 9/9/2023 (7:00 am - 3 pm)



Class Description:

The Bow Hunter Education Course is a nationally approved curriculum designed to teach bow hunters the knowledge, skills and ethics to becoming safe and responsible archery hunters. The covered topics include basic bow and arrow nomenclature, safe bow and arrow carrying practices, distance-judging techniques, wildlife conservation, wildlife identification, hunting ethics, hunt preparations, hunting techniques, tracking skills, shot placement, basic survival skills, basic navigation skills, basic first aid, game recovery, field dressing, game care and much more. Most states in America require a Bow Hunter Education certificate in order to obtain an archery hunting license. The Bow Hunter Education Certificate does not replace the regular Hunter Education Certificate. Both are required in states that require them. The certificate issued is valid in all states requiring it, and is good for life. The Bow Hunter Course includes 3-D archery field shooting at various targets and distances, including using a ground blind and tree stand. Bring a bow, arrows and guiver. Traditional and compound bows are acceptable. Use field tips on the arrows, no broadheads for the course targets.



RANGEMASTER SOUND-OFF

Want to be an RSO?

If you are interested in becoming a Rangemaster/RSO for Escondido Fish And Game Association please contact me and we can discuss the requirements. We will have an NRA Basic Range Safety Officer Course coming soon.

Guests

Members pay attention to your guests. Each member is allowed to bring **two** guests. They are your responsibility. Make sure they understand and follow all the rules.

Range Cold Blue Lights

Blue Blinking lights on or off applies to all ranges. If the Blue Blinking lights are on, DO NOT handle firearms. Do not unload firearms or gear from your vehicle. Sign the Green Sheet and wait for the range to go HOT. Then you can unload your firearms and gear.

The Green Sheets

There are Green Sheets being turned in without the Date and Range lines filled in. Please check and fill in the Date and Range information if it is missing.

Watch for Wildlife

Watch for Turkeys, Deer and other wildlife on the range. If any wildlife wanders (or flies) onto the range, call a "CEASE FIRE" until they leave. Shooting to scare them away is not acceptable.

Clean Up After Yourself

This is an Association of Members. YOU are the staff that cleans up after YOU. All shooters must remove their targets from the target backers and take them home. This is a HAZMAT requirement. Return the target frames to the designated area. This is a courtesy requirement. Take a look around. Did you leave the range a little nicer than you found it? Did you remember to take all your stuff home? There is no one to watch it until you can get back for it and we can't leave firearms on the premises over night.




