Projects

Flagpole Monument – At the time of this writing, the crane operator has been scheduled, cancelled, and re-scheduled a few times due to weather and illnesses. We are not giving up. We keep calling for another date and time to try it again. Although it is inconvenient for our timeline, I understand that the crane operator cannot take unnecessary risks with a 50-foot crane on a windy day. If all goes as planned, the top half of the flagpole will be in place by the time that you read this. We still need to apply a few coats of sealant and finish before the plaques are mounted on the faces of the concrete structure. Finally, low-voltage LED lighting will be installed to illuminate the flag at night.

100-Yard Remodel – The project has been pushed back a couple of weeks so that we can complete the Flagpole Monument project before starting another major project. With that in mind, we are still proceeding with the applications for the proper permits from the County so that we can do it all by-the-book. Bow Hunter Education Class

12/10/2022, 2/11/2023 & 4/18/2023 (7:00 am – 4 pm)

Class Description:

The Bow Hunter Education Course is a nationally approved curriculum designed to teach bow hunters the knowledge, skills, and ethics to becoming safe and responsible archery hunters. The covered topics include basic bow and arrow nomenclature, safe bow and arrow carrying practices, distance-judging techniques, wildlife conservation, wildlife identification, hunting ethics, hunt preparations, hunting techniques, tracking skills, shot placement, basic survival skills, basic navigation skills, basic first aid, game recovery, field dressing, game care and much more. Most states in America require a Bow Hunter Education certificate in order to obtain an archery hunting license. The Bow Hunter Education Certificate does not replace the regular Hunter Education Certificate. Both are required in states that require them. The certificate issued is valid in all states requiring it, and is good for life. The Bow Hunter Course includes 3-D archery field shooting at various targets and distances, including using a ground blind and tree stand. Bring a bow, arrows and quiver. Traditional and compound bows are acceptable. Use field tips on the arrows, no broadheads for the course targets.

Hello everyone,

For casual shooting you are not allowed to draw a handgun from a holster. Drawing from a holster is only allowed at sanctioned events. Also during casual shooting, you are not allowed to rapid fire. Rapid firing is only allowed at sanctioned events. When shooting a shotgun for casual shooting you are only allowed to load two rounds at a time.

Members bringing guests to the range need to have the guests with them at all times except when using the restrooms. You are responsible for your guests.

We're still seeing Green Sheets turned in with no Date and Range information filled in. When you sign the Green Sheet, please make sure that the Date and Range are correct.

Please remove your targets from the target backers and return the target frames back to the designated area. Remember to take your used targets and shot gun hulls home. Per Hazmat rules, we are not allowed to put them in the trash on the range. Even though they can be recycled, that needs to be done on your own property.

Lost and Found continues to grow. When you leave the range, look around. Make sure you take everything home with you.



Trap Straights – Why We Do It

Shooting a trap straight is breaking all 25 targets in succession thrown for an individual by a trap machine during a single squad with an “official” score keeper. Breaking ALL 25 of them for the first time is more than just fun, it can be the fulfillment of a long and (often) agonizing path to personal success in a chosen, competitive sport/discipline. Every one of the people who are listed in our Trap Straights column have achieved a significant goal, but for those listed as 1st 25 STRAIGHT – SHOT HIS/HER HAT!!, it is the achievement of a pinnacle, a very memorable “first time in your life” moment that will never be repeated. This gets a little more complicated when you achieve a straight in other games. In Doubles, there are 13 pairs (26 birds) and that is a particularly challenging feat to accomplish. Getting a 25 in 5-Stand is almost impossible but every so often, someone does it. Just as rare is a 25 from Handicap (27 Yards behind the Trap machine). If you look at the list of Straights every month, you might notice some patterns emerge. We have some really good Trap shooters in our Association. If you want to improve your scores and perhaps even shoot your hat someday, it’s easy to figure out who to ask for pointers.

Stop by any scheduled Tuesday, Wednesday or Saturday Trap event and see what the fun is all about.

Improving Your Score

Many people ask how to get to that next level of Trap greatness. I recommend three habits of excellence:

1. Help your puller. Learn how to keep score and operate the ‘pickle’. The person running the event that day really appreciates the help and you also get a different perspective of the game.
2. Help load the house. Not only does this make the down-time go faster but also you get to see the equipment up close. This can only help your game.
3. Show up for a Work Party. This may sound ridiculous, but it worked for me. The day that I shot my hat I had spent the morning doing a Work Party. Perhaps I was too tired to over-think the game but it was a great day for me.

I suppose you could also practice a lot and shoot with people who are better than you to elevate your game but the three habits above worked for me.
