

#### COVID Update

At the time of this writing, it looks like the CDC/State/County is changing the guidelines for outdoor gatherings and mask requirements. Before we get all excited and ignore all safety measures, we need to make note of some important distinctions:

**Vaccination Requirements** – The CDC and the State of California have set guidelines for how many people can congregate at a PRIVATE outdoor event. The number of people allowed is much higher if we require proof of vaccination. However, we do not want to incur the liabilities of requiring participants to share their personal medical records with us in order to participate in an event. If you suffer from insomnia, look up HIPAA.

Crowded Events – The president, governor, and the CDC were very specific to state that masks are not required for VACCINATED people in OUTDOOR settings EXCEPT for situations with crowds of people. We would all love to twist this to our advantage but I don't think that we can get away with it unless we keep the social distance requirement enforced. That would make any of our shooting events impractical.

Changing Rules – The one thing that we have learned over the past year is that the guidelines and requirements are always changing. Hopefully, the State will announce relaxed restrictions in response to the CDC announcements. The best situation for us would be having San Diego County move to the Yellow tier so that there would be a lighter set of requirements.

In summary, it looks like we will continue to need masks for our events that have a crowd of people in close proximity. In my opinion this means that during the Work Party while everyone is spread out, this would not be an issue. However, while everyone is lined up for lunch (in a crowd), we should probably mask up. A shooting event with everyone in squads (crowds), we should probably mask up. Remaining compliant keeps us under the radar and out of the news.

#### **Pistol Range Improvements**

While the Range was closed for lead reclamation in March, one of the many projects that were done was extending the short-range (5, 7, & 10 yards) target slots on the Pistol Range. This popular improvement makes it possible to spread out more while others are using Range. It also adds flexibility of classes and other events.

The one issue with the short-range target slots is that when a target frame is close to you and the target is high on the frame, your bullets may impact the hill above the proper impact zone. In order to accommodate this issue, we have made numerous target frames that are about a foot shorter for use in the shot-range target slots.

If you ask any Junior Rifle/Pistol/Trap participant what Firearm Safety Rule #4 is, they will tell you - Know your target and its surroundings. As we all know, the Firearm Safety Rules are not just for Juniors, they are for everyone.





Primitive Rifle - Same as Open Rifle, but must load from a bag. Fixed Iron Sights only.

**Cartridge Rile** - Any original or period correct black powder cartridge rifle, using cast lead bullets, using black powder as a propellant.

**Note:** There are no contest results for March as the event was cancelled due to lead reclamation and recycling.



**No Illegal Transactions** may be advertised in this newsletter. It is now illegal to sell ammunition in California without either going through an FFL or a licensed ammunition reseller. EF&GA cannot facilitate any illegal commerce of a state regulated commodity. This is also why firearm sales should include a phrase similar to Buyer pays DROS when advertising the sale of a firearm.

It may sound obvious but requests for classifieds are frequently received with not enough information to be useful to a reader.

There are 5 main components of a classified ad:


**Category** – Most classifieds fall into one of 3 categories, 'For Sale', 'Wanted', or 'Lost & Found'.

**Subject/Title** – This will appear in bold in the advertisement. This should be short (2 or 3 words) and concise.

**Description** – This is the body of the advertisement and can be a few sentences but not more than a paragraph. Abbreviations appear cryptic and are not recommended unless they are well known acronyms.

**Price** – A specific dollar amount as well as qualifiers give the reader important information. For example, "\$600 or Best Offer, Buyer pays DROS, Will consider trades"

**Contact Info** – This should be a name AND a phone number (including area code) and/or an e-mail address.
