The Landscape Work Party on March 27<sup>th</sup> was a huge success. We had 91 eager volunteers that accomplished an awful lot of work.

The Landscape Committee led by **Alonzo Clark** and **Breen Emery** have been planning this event for many months. They set up teams including the Trimmers, Weed Whackers, Lumber Jacks, Skidders and Chippers. It was amazing to watch as everyone was clearing brush, dead and fallen trees from beyond the fence perimeter. The material was either thrown over the fence or skidded out with 4WD vehicles and the tractor and gators. It was taken to the Chipper/Shredder that ran constantly from about 7:30 am until 3:30 pm.





At the same time the masterful Lumber Jacks were cutting down 10-12 dead or dying trees in the campground which were either fed to the chipper or bucked into firewood sized rounds. At the May Work Party we plan to split all of those rounds for firewood. The mulch created by the Chipper/Shredder will be spread around the plants and trees all over the range.



NRA Metallic Cartridge Reloading Course 5/7/2022, 7/2/2022 (1st Session 8 am – Noon)

#### **Class Description:**

Did anyone expect this ammo shortage to last this long and affect us so seriously? Need or want ammo but can't find any? You're left with an old American skill; self-sufficiency and creativity...Make your own!

This class will supply you with the knowledge of how to properly and safely reload your used casings into economical, effective and accurate ammunition. As you hone your new found reloading knowledge you will also improve your shooting skills.

#### The class is structured in two sessions:

1<sup>st</sup> session – This class is strictly academic and is held in the EF&GA Meeting Hall.

**2**<sup>nd</sup> **session** – This is "Hands On" training scheduled with a mutually agreed to time and date where you will reload your own cartridges on my reloading bench utilizing my equipment that day.

#### **NRA Basic Shotgun Class** 6/12/2022 (8 am – 5 pm)


#### **Class Description:**







## **BLACK POWDER NEWS**

Next Muzzle Loading Bullseye: No contest in May.

**Next Primitive Archery:** Scheduled for May 1st in the Campground. Contact **David Premetz** at 760-489-1082 or <a href="mailto:slixgunr@yahoo.com">slixgunr@yahoo.com</a> for more information.

**Next Muzzle Loading Silhouette:** Scheduled for May 22nd on the 150 range. This is the Super Short Course with targets at 25, 50, and 75 yards for Rifle and TRADE GUN. Single Shot Pistol and Revolver will be at the same distance.

**NOTE:** This contest is designed for the brand new or inexperienced, entry level black powder shooters. If you want to shoot your replica Hawken, or Kentucky rifle in a contest, THIS is where you start. It also allows those who shoot Trade guns a chance to compete at a reasonable distance. Knocking down steel silhouettes with a black powder rifle is fun, but can be frustrating when the silhouettes "dodge" those close shots.

You need to bring your own equipment. There will be experienced shooters competing, that can walk you through the program. We will help if you have a problem. If you have been "on the fence" about shooting your black powder rifle or pistol, this contest is for you. Both Rifle and Pistol will require up to 18 rounds to complete the course of fire.

Range setup starts at 0630. Pistol starts at 0830. Rifle starts at 10:00. Sorry, we don't shoot "In-lines". Contact **Garth Warner** for more information at <a href="mailto:gwarner@cox.net">gwarner@cox.net</a> or 760-738-5070 from 9am to 8pm.

**Rifles:** Last month I talked about pistols and revolvers that could be used in Silhouette contests. This month let's look at Rifles. There are lots of black powder rifles to choose from. Do your homework before you buy.

As I said last month, you are looking for something with a slow twist barrel. Many modern manufactures are offering fast twist (1-28) barrels for Sabots in "replica" rifles used for hunting. We shoot only patched round ball. For Round Ball, look for a rifle with a twist of 1-48 OR SLOWER.

The most common pre-owned replica rifles you can find are going to be Thompson Center Hawken rifles. These most often come with a 1/48 twist barrel. Also available are Traditions, CVA, or Dixie rifles. These can be found in Hawken or Kentucky Rifle configurations. Of the above, pre-owned Thompson Center rifles can get to be unreasonably pricey. The ballpark for a pre-owned Thompson Center, in good shape, is around \$300. If you

can find a Thompson Center rifle with a Green Mountain Drop In Replacement barrel, snap it up, or be prepared to pay more. The Green Mountain barrels are 1-70 twist, and very accurate at range with the right loading.

I know some of the Traditions rifles were offered in a 1-66 barrel twist. This would be about right for Round Ball. Of all the currently manufactured rifles, I would take a look at the Lyman Great Plains Rifle (Not the Hunter or Signature Series). These can be purchased as kits, or as assembled rifles. They can be pricey at \$550 to \$750 new, or frequently less expensive if pre-owned.

Finally, Pedersoli offers a variety of black powder rifles with fast twist barrels and a shiny finish. They are VERY pricy (1K and up). With fast twist barrels, they are not suitable for the course of fire that we shoot. If you are in the market for a black powder rifle, come out to one of our contests and see what other people are shooting before you make a financial mistake.

**Caliber:** The most common rifles we see at the contests are a few 45s, a lot of 50s, and 54s. Anything smaller than this (32s, 36s, or 40s) will struggle to knock down the steel silhouettes at range. The argument about which is "best" is ongoing and never ending. Note that most of the Master Class shooters use 54's. Draw your own conclusions.

**Action:** Percussion or Flintlock? Up to you to decide. Percussion is a little easier to get started in. It can be a little more challenging to make flintlocks work reliably until you develop some skill with them. Whatever floats your boat.

**Next Time:** Support gear to make it happen. I will list what you need to get started for shooting from the bench at the range.
