### Darrin's Dissertation

Last month, we had some unusual weather. After a few weeks of unbearable heat and humidity, we had the remnants of Hurricane Kay march through our area causing havoc. At my house in Oceanside, we had a little wind, some mild and intermittent rain, but nothing major.

When I went to the Range on Saturday (after the storms), I found that Valley Center had a very different experience. There were trees knocked over, broken branches blown down, chairs and 5-Stand cages scattered around, and general mayhem left behind. **Chris Cote** and **Mark Baldwin** surveyed the damage so that we had an idea of the scope of the problem.

The next morning, **Chris Cote** and I got together and used the tractor, my pickup truck, rope, chains, and some tree-cutting equipment to start clearing out the mess. It seemed like every few minutes I was dragging another branch or limb over to the open area between the Campground and the 150 Range. **Jim McKim** had just finished running the 22 Silhouette Match when he came over to find out what was going on. Now there were three of us getting the property cleared for safety and beauty. After a long day of at least getting the big chunks cleared out, we had quite a pile of brush and debris.

The next day I talked to **Dean Dorman** about what to do with that huge pile of brush and debris. At first we considered getting a large dumpster and having it hauled away but dumpsters are expensive and in short supply. The soonest that we could get one would be a week later. After some emails around to people involved, **Jim McKim** went out and hacked up the big pieces into smaller and more manageable pieces. Also, **Dean Dorman** and **'Tuck'** got together and cleared more brush along the Archery Range, the Campground, and the 150 Range. Now we had a large pile of brush fire fuel and snake habitat.

I was off work the following Friday afternoon and after some brainstorming, phone calls to vendors, and discussions with some smart EF&GA members, we decided to rent a wood chipper and get it done. I picked one up in Valley Center and towed it to the Range. **Gary Fukuda** was there working on the cement forms for the Flagpole Monument and generously agreed to operate the tractor so that I could feed the wood chipper. While we were getting set up, we ran into **Linda Linaker's** adopted grandson, **Nathan Elliott (Hot Dog)** at the Pistol Range. He agreed to help feed the chipper, and in one afternoon, we ground up the entire pile of brush and debris.

When all of this started a week earlier, we identified a safety concern. We got together and addressed the problem directly. Along the way, people stepped up and helped solve the problem. Nobody complained, we just got together and got it done. I found it inspiring that members of the Association saw what was happening and wanted to be part of the solution. I consider it an honor to be part of an Association that is made up of such fine people.

#### **Letter From an Old Friend**


Howdy Folks,



#### **Keeping It All Together**

At the Range, we have three regular Trap machines in the bunkers and ten other machines used for 5-Stand. Many of us have helped set them up, tear them down, and load them with targets. Have you ever considered what it takes to keep them all operational? After dealing with a few issues and assisting in some repairs, I have come to the conclusion that they were originally designed by Rube Goldberg. They carefully remove a clay target from the bottom of the stack and on command throw the target at speeds up to 60 miles per hour without breaking the targets. With all of the moving parts like motors, hydraulic pumps, valves, sensors, cams, elevators, rubber bands, other widgets, there is a lot that can go wrong. So, constant maintenance is required.

Bill Sargent maintains the three Trap machines in the bunkers. At his day-job, he owns a fabrication company that uses precision CNC machines. His understanding of hydraulics, circuitry, and experience with these machines made him a great fit to keep them going. He is also an excellent Trap and Pot shooter.


