## 100-Yard Range Remodel Project FAQs

## Q: What will we get for our money?

## A: The following features will be added:

- All work will be performed with the proper required permits from the County of San Diego and the work will be performed primarily by EF&GA volunteers.
- The concrete slab will be extended to the West by 15 feet creating an additional 4 shooting positions (two shooting benches with two seats per bench is 4 shooting positions).
- The concrete apron (forward of the firing line) will be removed and replaced with a new apron that will have proper water runoff and will be properly tied to the main slab.
- The concrete apron on the East side (under the target frame storage) will be removed and replaced with a new apron that will have proper water runoff and will be properly tied to the main slab.
- The pillars holding up the overhead structure will be augmented with reinforced concrete cladding creating a more uniform appearance as well as a longer-lasting structure.
- The overhead structure (including the roof) will be remodeled with a modern, square, straight, level, and plumb structure that is more compatible with the structures at the Pistol and 150-Yard ranges. It will not be identical, but it will be similar.
- Electrical features (lighting, and power for other utilities) will be included in the overhead structure in line with the electrical features at the Pistol and 100-Yard ranges.
- The existing railroad-tie fence at the West end will be removed and the materials will be later used as sacrificial facia for the Steel Target Frame structure at the end of the 100-Yard Range.
- The Steel Target Frame structure at the end of the 100-Yard Range will be moved to the West by 15 feet to service the four new shooting positions at the West end of the Ramada.
- The service road leading to the brow-ditch above the impact area will be adjusted and improved to accommodate the relocated Steel Target Frame structure at the end of the 100-Yard Range.

Q: What will happen with the 100-Yard Range during the construction process? A: When the project is started, the firing line will be moved to the 25-Yard Line with two 10' x 20' temporary outdoor carport structures.

- Targets placed on the 50-Yard line will be 25 yards from the temporary firing line.
- Targets placed on the 75-Yard line will be 50 yards from the temporary firing line.
- Targets placed on the 100-Yard line will be 75 yards from the temporary firing line.
- The Steel Target Structure will be roughly 95 yards from the temporary firing line.
