The February cleaning protest is still on. Check the website before you come up in case we have to change things at the last minute. That is actually a good idea whenever you head to the range.

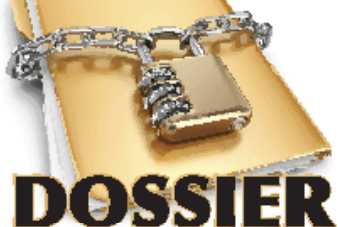

COVID-19 Update

In late December, the State of California went back to a Shelter-in-Place status and we were forced to change our sanctioned events back to Members-Only to keep the participant numbers low. None of us were happy about this but it had to be done.

At the end of January, the Stay-at-Home order was lifted and the regional classification system went back to county-by-county. When San Diego County went back to 'purple status' and restaurants are now allowed to have seated dining (outdoors), the Board of Directors voted to open up our sanctioned events for Members and Invited Guests again effective 2/1/2021.

Members & IG

Now that many of our events are open to Members and Invited Guests, you have the option to bring non-members to a sanctioned event that is in [Members & IG] status. 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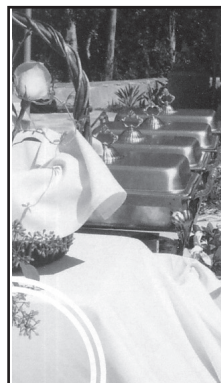

Life Member Nominations

Below is an excerpt from the EF&GA bylaws regarding Life Membership:

Life members shall consist of the member elected to Life Membership & their spouse, if any. [...] Not more than two Life members may be elected in any one-year. Candidates for Life Membership shall have been Regular or Senior members of the Association for at least three years prior to their candidacy for Life Membership and must have performed "outstanding service" for the Association. This "outstanding service" must have been performed over a period of time and must consist of more than a single act. It must be of such a nature that it can be documented by the Committee for presentation to the Board of Directors. It is desirable that candidates have performed outstanding leadership such as an Officer or Board Member or Chairperson of the Association in a satisfactory manner.

Nominations for EF&GA Life Membership are open now and may be submitted to the committee (Geof Orchin, Neil Pisk, and Bud Smith) in writing (email or snail-mail). If you have any questions about the process or how to nominate someone, please contact a committee member.

Range Closure (3/8/2021-3/15/2021)

We have contracted with a lead reclamation firm to mitigate the lead from the Trap Ranges and they will need to have the ranges closed for a week to get their equipment in place and process the material. Because the hillside for the Trap Ranges are in the line of sight for all of the Ranges, the Pistol, 100, and 150 Ranges will need to be closed as well during this week.

While the Ranges are closed, we also plan to complete a number of other projects around the ranges to improve and maintain the infrastructure of the Association. Improvements will be made on the Pistol, Trap, and 100-Yard Ranges that will require trenching for electrical and concrete as well as other structural features. If you are interested in participating in these projects, please contact Chis Cote or myself.

Protest (2/21/2021)

Because COVID-19 does not spread at peaceful protests, we are having a protest against messy ranges. We plan to eradicate messes and vegetation waste that could become brushfire fuel. Pack Your Hulls

Because the State of California has changed the rules again, we need to change how we handle any waste materials at the Range. We are moving to a 'pack-your-trash' model where you will be required to take your used hulls home with you rather than leaving them in the buckets or trash cans. Used hulls consist of plastic and mostly steel so you should be able to dispose of them in your home recycling but we cannot put them in our commercial recycling at the Range because they contain minute amounts of lead, zinc, antimony, or copper. According to the State of California, you cannot dispose of this type of waste in a commercial environment. Residential waste/recycling has a different set of rules.

Other ranges in our region have been cited and fined heavily for violations of this regulation. We don't want to be the next range to get fined heavily.

SAFETY FIRST

Folks; I need to get your attention in regards to Safety on the range before there is an incident that everyone will regret.

I was working the range during the last week of January, the Holiday week when a lot of members had time off and nowhere else to go. The range was busy with a lot of members bringing guests that they were trying to help.

I started my rounds at the Pistol range and found my first violation. Handling firearms at the table behind the firing line.

I have harped about this numerous times... There is the possibility, however slight that there may be a live round in your firearm! While it may be inconvenient it is much Safer to bring your firearm (in it's case) to the firing line to make sure it is clear. Just do it – Please.

From the Pistol range I headed over to the 100 yard Rifle range and noticed several shooters on the firing line. As I stepped onto the range I see a shooter passing the Red Firing Line with a target stand and notice the Cold lights are not on (again). At that moment my brain went into “Matrix Time” and tried to register - am I really seeing this...

- Shooter past the Red line going down range and No lights on – This is not good
- Shooter going down range, No lights and other shooters in front of Yellow line – This is really not good
- Shooter going down range, No lights, and other shooter has pistol in hand pointing down range getting ready to fire – This is really, really not good
- Cease Fire!!, Cease Fire!!, Cease Fire!!
- %&\$)_^% the heck is going on here!

I would like to “highly suggest” that if you call the range Cold make sure EVERYONE has gone Cold and is behind the Yellow line before passing the Red FIRING line – just saying!

Cold Range:

- Blue Blinking Lights **ON**
- **DO NOT** handle Firearms & Equipment
- Handle Targets
- Sweep up brass behind the Yellow and in front of the Red line

OK TO GO DOWN RANGE

Hot Range:

- Blue Blinking Lights **OFF**
- Handle Firearms & Equipment
- OK to Load/Unload Vehicle
- Sweep up brass behind Red line

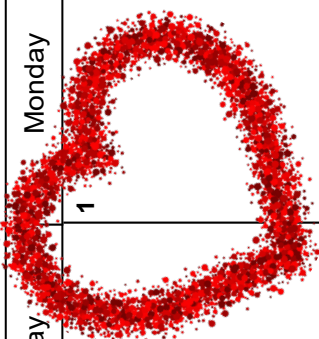
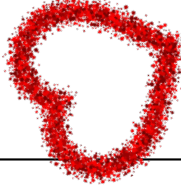

Members Only are allowed to submit Classified advertisements. Your Membership Number must be included with any advertisement request so that we can properly vet the submission before it is published. The Membership Number will NOT appear in the advertisement. Your Membership Number is on your membership badge on the same side as your photo.

No Illegal Transactions may be advertised in this newsletter. It is now illegal to sell ammunition in California without either going through an FFL or a licensed ammunition reseller. EF&GA cannot facilitate any illegal commerce of a state regulated commodity. This is also why firearm sales should include a phrase similar to Buyer pays DROS when advertising the sale of a firearm.

It may sound obvious but requests for classifieds are frequently received with not enough information to be useful to a reader.

There are 5 main components of a classified ad:

Category – Most classifieds fall into one of 3 categories, 'For Sale', 'Wanted', or 'Lost & Found'.

Subject/Title – This will appear in bold in the advertisement. This should be short (2 or 3 words) and concise.

Description – This is the body of the advertisement and can be a few sentences but not more than a paragraph. Abbreviations appear cryptic and are not recommended unless they are well known acronyms.

Price – A specific dollar amount as well as qualifiers give the reader important information. For example, "\$600 or Best Offer, Buyer pays DROS, Will consider trades"

Contact Info – This should be a name AND a phone number (including area code) and/or an e-mail address.
