Correction to Brass Bucket Bullet Point

There was some confusion in last month's Bullet Points about the brass in the brass buckets. This is to set the record straight.

Statement: The brass in the brass buckets at each kiosk belongs to the Junior Marksmanship Program. There is no Association bylaw, no Association policy, or Range rule that states the brass in the brass bucket belongs to the Junior Marksmanship Program. There have recently been stickers placed on the buckets that state such, but those stickers have been placed without authority of the Board of Directors.

Statement: While it is fine to reclaim your own brass from the ground or that of a friend, it is not OK to take brass from the brass buckets. This is a false statement. The Board of Directors or any RSO has no enforcement in place. It is, however, true that any brass in the buckets is collected, and the proceeds after recycling go to help fund the Junior Marksmanship Program.

Linda Linaker knabbed a CVA Pennsylvania .45 Long Rifle.



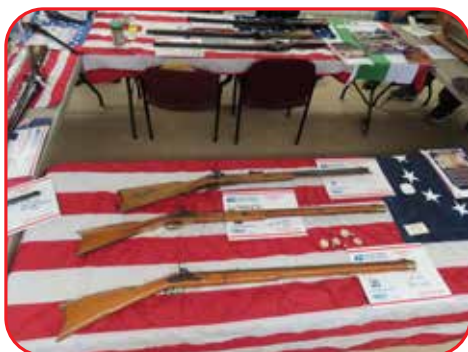
Drake Duplessis grins with delight at his new 1841 Mississippi .58 Rifle.

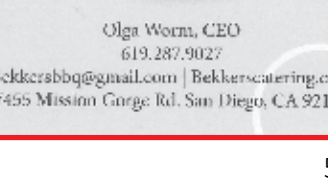

BLACK POWDER NEWS

Upcoming Events...

Muzzle Loading Bullseye:

August 2nd is our Annual Rifle Fest. This event will include five tasks as listed below.

Event #1 Starting at 08:00 we will have a 150 yard Benchrest contest for Muzzle Loading Rifles. Best 10 of 13 rounds will count on an NRA A-21 target. There will be two divisions to include Percussion and Flintlock.

Event #2 Starting at 09:00 we will have a Buffalo Harvest Match. This will be a five round contest. Two shots offhand and three shots from cross sticks. We will again have two divisions to include Percussion and Flintlock. The highest scoring shooter using a **Traditional Hawken** rifle will earn a special award.

Event #3 Starting at 09:30 (ish) we will have a **Mike Fink** Challenge shoot. Roughly, this will be a human silhouette outline with a whiskey bottle on the head (One shot only). The closest shot to the center of the whiskey bottle wins. Hitting the human silhouette is a DQ. There is a Mountain Man story associated with this that I will not go into here.

Event #4 09:45 (ish) Shooting the V. This is one target with a black V printed on a white background at 25 yards. One shot closest to the bottom of the V without touching the V wins.

Event #5 10:00 to noon ? The Seneca Run. This is a timed event where single shooters walk or run on a closed course to shoot five steel silhouettes at "unknown" distances. It is approximately a 400 yard "Run", where overage men walk, stumble and crawl, while reloading from a pouch, and supervised by an RO. Time stops when you run past the last cone and "stick" a tomahawk. Individual times range from 12 to 30 minutes each. CPR trained staff will be on hand....

SPAR is the abbreviation for the Society of Primitive American Riflemen. We founded the Escondido Fish and Game Association chapter in 2009. Our original purpose was to provide activities for our members that were germane to the period of American history ending in approximately 1850. This includes the frontier explorations of the early eastern woodsmen, the mountain men of the Rocky Mountains, the plainsmen who guided wagon trains to the West, the Buffalo hunters of the Great Plains, and early settlers in the West.
