Class Description:

This class will provide the knowledge to properly and safely reload your used casings into economical, effective and accurate ammunition. The class is structured in two separate sessions:

1st session – This class is strictly academic and is held in the EF&GA Meeting Hall on the above date from 8am until noon.

2nd session – This is “Hands-On” training scheduled with a mutually agreed upon time and date where you will reload your own cartridges on the reloading bench that day.

Amateur Trapshooting Association Competition

The ATA (**Amateur Trapshooting Association**) world trapshooting championships were held in Sparta, Illinois August 3 to August 8th.

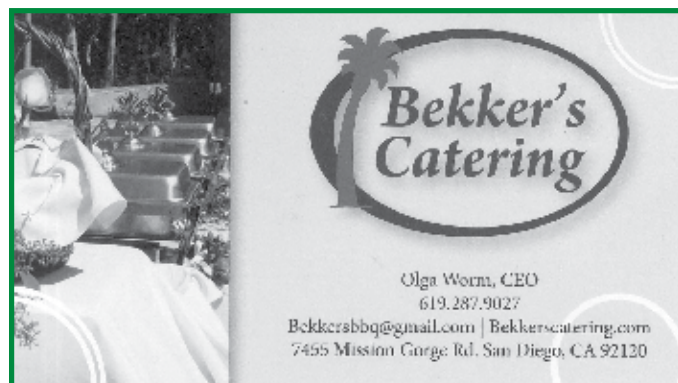
Escondido Fish and Game Association member, **Rich Davis**, competed in the 1000 target tournament.

Rich Davis shot 99 out of 100 doubles in the championship event. All American and hall of fame member, **Jimmy Heller**, also shot a 99 in the senior veteran category. Being tied and shooting for the senior veteran championship, a shoot off was necessary. Doubles shoot off is two pairs fired from each post for a total of 20 targets. **Jimmy Heller** won the shoot off, 19 to 17. The competition between Rich and Jimmy was fierce as the two competitors have been roommates at the grands for 10 years. Congratulations to Rich and Jimmy.

Junior Trap - New addition to the Trap Corner

Our Junior Trap program is going strong and growing. We hold Junior Trap every 2nd Saturday at 5pm. Our last Junior Trap had 25 returning youth. These are youth who have been shooting with our program at least once. The returning shooters continue to be introduced to a straight away bird and are coached 1 on 1 on how to correct any missed shots they may have. We had 6 advanced youth. These are shooters who have shown muzzle and trigger discipline along with growth in tracking and breaking birds. Advanced shooters can shoot either 5 stand or regular scored trap with a coach and a puller assisting the shooting line. At this month's Junior Trap Event, we had 14 new shooters who had never shot with us. Many of them had never shot a gun before.

Muzzle Loading Bullseye:

Range Master Sound Off

THINK SAFETY

Safety is every member's responsibility. That's why we say, "Every member is an RSO" (Range Safety Officer). If the guy next to you is doing something unsafe, you could be the one to suffer the consequences. It is in your best interest to "Remind" them of the proper procedure or policy. We know. Sometimes that's hard. You don't want to feel like you're "nagging" or "snitching". That isn't the objective, a safe range is.

Most of the time that member to member reminder is enough. A respectful member should not push back. They should correct the unsafe behavior and move on. On those rare occasions when someone doesn't, please let us know. You can call an RSO or the Chief Range Safety Officer or you can fill out an incident report located in the Meeting Hall. Collect the necessary information. It does no good to say, "Some guy did something wrong". Get the member's name. If they decline to tell you, it should be on the Green Sheet. If it was a guest, the member that brought them is responsible. What was the date and time of the incident? What exactly happened? Was an RSO informed? Who?

If you are "the guy that did something wrong", take responsibility for your action. Transgressions happen. They are easily fixed with a reminder. Accept that your fellow member has good intentions. Bad attitudes are another thing. There is no room for bad attitudes on a gun range. It cannot be tolerated. The consequences are too high.

We have a very safe range and we want to keep it that way. You are an integral part of that. Remember what our Association president often writes. "Be safe, have fun and respect your fellow members."
