
The berm for the 150 yard range is finished. We gained about 6 ft. of height. We still need to look at the right side near the fence and I believe we have a plan for that. We used the dirt from the trap and 100 yard range. We leveled it all off and filled it in with about 3 inches of dg. This will help events that set up down range as well as cleanup of the wads.

As far as the Range Improvement Project goes, the new plans have been submitted to the County. They will probably review the plans and return them in a couple of weeks for corrections. They always have corrections. However, our architect is on top of things and we should be able to pull the permit soon. The Health Department still wants to hold off until the end of this Month to make sure the water table stays where it is. On the last check, the one in the campground was at 9 ft. 9 inches. This is good since we may be able to put the leach field in and eliminate having to pump the tank so often.

The bylaws committee met and has a few minor changes which should be in this bulletin. Our intent is to clean up some language and enhance a couple of areas. Also, the finance committee met and came up with some great solutions. I want to thank all those who volunteered for these tasks.

Since I spend a lot of time up at the range, several people have commented on how nice the place looks. I usually reply back and tell them that we have a good staff.

# PROPOSED BYLAW CHANGES

**Proposed by law changes approved by the Board of Directors. These proposed changes will be presented to the EF&GA members present at the May 13, 2010 Member's meeting for approval.**

The underlined items are proposed for removal or amendment.

## ARTICLE V Board of Directors

### Section 1. Composition

The Board of Directors shall be comprised of the President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer and seven (7) members who meet the following qualifications:

. The Treasurer is a non voting member of the Board of Directors.

### Section 2. Officers

(b) Treasurer: The Treasurer shall be appointed by a majority vote of the Board of Directors to ensure that candidates have sufficient experience and background to competently handle the responsibilities of the office.

(d) Term of Office for Treasurer: The Treasurer shall serve at the pleasure of the Board, subject to the rights, if any, of the Treasurer under any contract of retention or employment.

### Section 4. Treasurer

The Treasurer shall be the custodian of all Association funds. He/she shall keep such funds in a safe place as may be directed by the Board of Directors, give an accounting at every board meeting and every general meeting, pay out money as directed by the Board of Directors or as authorized in these By-laws, keep a record of all income and expenditures by appropriate account numbers, such record to show the income and expenditure for the current month, for the year to date and a comparison to budget, assist the Budget Committee in preparing the annual budget and in making quarterly budget comparisons to actual income and expenditures and submit the records for audit as and when required by the Board of Directors.

### Section 11. Membership

The Association Clerk need not be a member of the Association.

## ARTICLE XI Employees

### Section 2. Employment Process

The President shall interview, negotiate, hire and fire all employees with the advice and consent of the Board of Directors. Employees will consist of, but necessarily be limited to, the Association Clerk, Maintenance Man, Trap Boys and such others that may be necessary from time to time.

## PROPOSED BY-LAWS (italicized)

### Section 6. Past Presidents

*Past Presidents, in good standing, are allowed to attend all meetings of the Association.*

## Board of Directors

### Section 1. Composition

*The Board of Directors shall be comprised of the President, Vice-President, Secretary, and seven (7) members who meet the following qualifications:*

### Section 2 – officers

*(e) The Board may grant a leave of absence to an officer or Board member for illness, illness in the family, or in order for the member to meet their employer's demands.*

### Section 10. Membership

*The Association Clerk need not be a member of the Association. If the Association Clerk is a member of EF&GA, he/she may not serve as an elected officer or director.*

### Section 2. Employment Process

*The President shall interview, negotiate, hire and fire all employees with the advice and consent of the Board of Directors. Employees will consist of, but necessarily be limited to, the Treasurer, the Association Clerk, Maintenance Man, Trap Boys and such others that may be necessary from time to time.*

## ARTICLE XII Association Treasurer

*(a) Treasurer: The Treasurer shall be appointed by a majority vote of the Board of Directors to ensure that candidates have sufficient experience and background to competently handle the responsibilities of the office.*

*(b) Term of Office for Treasurer: The Treasurer shall serve at the pleasure of the Board, subject to the rights, if any, of the Treasurer under any contract of retention or employment.*

*(c) Qualifications for the position of Treasurer: the Board of Directors, or a committee appointed by the Board, shall identify candidates for the position of Treasurer who, in the Board's judgment, possess the necessary education, background and experience to fulfill the demands of the office. The Board has the discretion to appoint a non-member to the position of Treasurer, or to retain a non-member to fulfill the position.*

*(d) The Treasurer shall be the custodian of all Association funds. He/she shall keep such funds in a safe place as may be directed by the Board of Directors, give an accounting at every board meeting and every general meeting, pay out money as directed by the Board of Directors or as authorized in these By-laws, keep a record of all income and expenditures by appropriate account numbers, such record to show the income and expenditure for the current month, for the year to date and a comparison to budget, assist the Budget Committee in preparing the annual budget and in making quarterly budget comparisons to actual income and expenditures and submit the records for audit as and when required by the Board of Directors. The Treasurer shall keep an accurate inventory of all property of the Association.*

*(e) If the Treasurer is a member of EF&GA, he/she may not serve as an elected officer or director.*



I believe I speak for the active RSO’s when I say thank you to those involved in the 150 yard range berm improvement. Raising the berm has removed an annoying problem for the RSO’s in keeping members target, target frame placement and correct target height to allow for proper bullet impact in the berm. The odd size frames presented a challenge for some members that kept taking the tall frames from the 100 yard range to the 150 yard range. The tall frame all but guaranteed the bullet going over the top of the berm. We are studying having one tall frame for all ranges and the short prone frames on the 150 yard range. We will keep you informed in this column.

Bob Schoenfield, The Trap Master, has started a 5 Stand Trap Pot. Those wishing to partake in this put \$1.00 for each round of 5 stand shot in the pot. After everyone has taken a few qualification rounds the first to shoot a 25 (that’s a perfect round) gets the pot, minus a small donation to Toys for Tots. Sounds like a lot of fun and Bob and I think there will be a lot on dollars in the pot by the time it is collected.

A thank you to Kerrie Dunks for the donation of new cardboard for the target frames. Kerrie donated a stack of pre-cut cardboard that stands over three feet high. All we have to do is make two cuts and we have three new target backs. For those of us involved in target cardboard can state, pre-cut is expensive. The pre-cut sheets will make life a bit easier for RSO’s that take time to refresh the target stands.

One last item - Please clean up your area, trash and brass, when you are done shooting. The association does not employ a cleaning crew. The mess you may leave behind is picked up either by another member or more than likely, an on duty RSO. The RSO’s have enough to do without picking up trash and sweeping up brass.




