



MARCH JUNIOR RIFLE SHOOT A SUCCESS!



NRA METALLIC COURSE CARTRIDGE RELOADING

The opportunity to learn how to reload is available Saturday, April 6th, 2013 at the EF&GA meeting hall. This course is a certified NRA reloading course (not sponsored by EF&GA). The NRA Metallic Cartridge Reloading Course will be conducted by Elvio Marchi, an NRA certified instructor. This NRA course will require that all students prove their proficiency with a "hands on" session for certification. In order to provide the accessibility to equipment necessary to accomplish this, the class will be divided into two segments. The academic portion will be held at the meeting hall on the range from 8:00 A.M. to Noon, but due to

equipment logistics, the hands on portion will be held at a separate location on an agreed upon day and hour. The class will be split into smaller groups to facilitate instruction of the "hands on" portion. This portion will be essential to completion of the course...certification cannot be issued without it. The fee will be \$65 (\$80 for individuals w/o supplies) for those individuals that have their own supplies (cases, powder, primers, projectiles and dies). Various caliber dies are available for use...check with Elvio on caliber availability. A non-refundable \$20 deposit will be required prior to registration. Class size is limited to 10 individuals. appy April Fool's Day. There is no fool like an April Fool (or so I have been told). Earth Day is 22 April, so do your part and do something for Mother Earth. Plant a tree, do not drive unless absolutely necessary, etc, etc.

It is time to talk about our Green Sheets, again. There are things the Green Sheets like to have but have been missing occasionally. So here we go. When you arrive on a range, the first thing you are to do is sign in on the Green Sheet.

- Check the top left of the sheet and make sure the current date is written on the appropriate line. If the date is missing, please print the date.
- The top right section is for the Range Safety Officers' to fill in.
- Under the "Name: Please Print" column, please print your name.
- "Category" column enter an 'M' for you, the Member and your Guest enters a 'G' if you have one.
- Time In/Out column, enter the time you arrived on the range and be sure to enter the time you leave the range.
- "Range" column is range you are on; "P" pistol, "100" for the 100 yard range and "150" for the 150 yard range. Trap range Green Sheet is located in the Trap Ramada and enter a "T". Archery folks sign in at the pistol range and enter an "A".
- The "RSO" is for Range Safety Officers' use.
- "Signature/Remarks", please sign.

The morning or afternoon RSO picks up the Greens Sheets and puts them in the appropriate container in the Clubhouse. I pick all of them up at the beginning of the following month. From the Green Sheets I develop a range usage report for the month.

There is a notice posted at the back wall of each range kiosk that details target placement and target frame usage. Each new member is given a copy of the range information and casual shooting rules and members of a longer tenure should know and practice range safety and target rules. Some of our members and their guests are still not placing targets on the target frame correctly; so, please help those folks and remind them of the range rules. We have neighbors that do not like bullets skipping into their property: And yes is has happened. The sand berms on the pistol range were put there to stop bullets from skipping to wherever.

Please make sure your bullets are impacting the back stop. This is one of the many items a Range Safety Officer on duty will check for while on the range.






