
when you step up to help with any activity.



### RANGEMASTER SOUND OFF



Range safety seems like a fairly simple thing sometimes. However, there can also be more to it than meets the eye and is not contained in the safety manual. Footwear is an excellent example of what I mean. Flip flops and open toed sandals might be a poor choice especially for the kids and for anyone who expects to be marching out to change targets. Also loose fitting shirts and blouses might be a bit of a challenge on the pistol range. If you choose to wear them be sure to keep your handgun pointed in a safe direction when hot brass from a neighbor decides to seek out your back or front! Take a little time; give some thought to what you are doing and what could go wrong. If you can imagine an unsafe situation arising, I can assure you that sooner or later it will. Being proactive is always better than being sorry. Act accordingly.

Nearly every week one of the RSOs reports that someone was told to cease their rapid fire. Usually it occurs on the Pistol Range, but it is does occur on one of the Rifle Ranges also. The official definition of "rapid fire" are shots less than one or two seconds apart. The RSO is the final arbiter of what constitutes "one or two seconds". You must be in control of your firearm at all times and for most people rapid fire means that you probably don't have the control that you should have.

As a sign of the times you may have noticed that there are a lot of signs at our range. There are signs telling you about Range Rules and where to park. What to shoot and what not to shoot. After a while they become a part of the landscape and it easy to ignore them. Why not take a moment every once in a while and actually read some of them. Two new one are going up soon. One of them tells you not to use iron core bullets on our range and the other will ask you to make certain that the gate closes so that unauthorized persons cannot follow you on to the range. It does happen all too often. When the gate is locked open the general public is allowed to enter. At all other times it the every members responsibility to see that the range is secure.




