NRA Metallic Cartridge Reloading Class 8/3/2024 & 10/5/2024 (8 am – 12 noon)

Ammunition is hard enough to find and expensive enough. Are there any better reasons to learn to reload your own ammunition?

Class Description:

This class will supply you with the knowledge of how to properly and safely reload your used casings into economical, effective and accurate ammunition. As you hone your new found reloading knowledge you will also improve your shooting skills.

The class is structured in two separate sessions:

1st session – This class is strictly academic and is held in the EF&GA Meeting Hall on the above dates from 8am until noon.

2nd session – This is “Hands-On” training scheduled with a mutually agreed upon time and date where you will reload your own cartridges on the reloading bench that day.

The cost of the class is \$125 for EF&GA members and \$135 for non-members. If you need supplies (e.g., cases, primers, projectiles and powder) they are available for a \$15 surcharge.

Prior registration is necessary and a \$20 nonrefundable deposit is required to secure a place in this limited class.

Hunter Education Class 8/10/2024 & 10/12/2024 (8 am – 4 pm)

Class Description:

The Hunter Education Course is a nationally approved curriculum designed to teach hunters the knowledge, skills and ethics to become safe and responsible hunters. The covered topics include basic firearms nomenclature, safe firearm loading/unloading practices, wildlife conservation, wildlife identification, hunting ethics, hunt preparations, hunting techniques, shot placement, bag limits, tracking skills, basic survival skills, basic navigation skills, basic first aid, game recovery, field dressing, game care and much more. Every state in America requires a Hunter Education Certificate in order to obtain a hunting license. The certificate issued is valid in all states and in numerous foreign countries, and is good for life. No live fire involved, firearms and ammunition are not required for the course.

RANGEMASTER SOUND-OFF

Hello Everyone,

CPR, First Aid, AED, Stop the Bleed

We will be offering a CPR, First Aid, Stop the Bleed, AED machine class for Members Only at this time. The class will be held in the Meeting Hall at EF&GA range. Members must have a Range Membership ID badge. Family Members without a badge will not be offered this class at this time. The class is \$55.00 including a certificate of completion. The class will be approximately five hours long. The date for the class is not scheduled yet pending interest. There will be thirty people in the class. Blue Blinking Lights

Blue Blinking lights on or off applies to all ranges. If the Blue Blinking lights are on, do not unload firearms or gear. Sign the Green Sheet and wait for the range to go hot (lights OFF). Then you can unload your firearms and gear. See the chart to the right as a guide.

The Green Sheets

Always sign the Green Sheet upon arrival. Make sure the "Range" and "Date" information is filled in.

Housekeeping as You Pack Up

All shooters are expected to remove their targets from the target backers and return the target frames to the designated area. CA HAZMAT regulations require us to take our targets home for disposal.

Look around and make sure you haven't left anything behind.

Mark Baldwin reports that there were two shotguns left at the range after a Tuesday Trap event. He was able to contact the owners and resolve the situation that day. On Thursday, July 11, a lever action Winchester was left on the 100 yard range. I would estimate that at least a dozen members tried to claim that one at the meeting that night. These serve as reminders to check around for your belongings before you leave the range. For the record, firearms are not left on the property overnight. Someone will have to take it home. You can get it back at THEIR convenience.

Cold Range:

- Blue Blinking Lights **ON**
- DO NOT Handle Firearms & Equipment
- Handle Targets
- Sweep Up Brass Behind the Yellow and In Front of the Red Line

OK TO GO DOWN RANGE

Hot Range:

- Blue Blinking Lights **OFF**
- Handle Firearms & Equipment
- OK to Load/Unload Vehicle
- Sweep up brass behind Red Line Only

DO NOT GO DOWN RANGE

Watch for Wildlife

As always, watch for wildlife on the range. If a turkey or deer wanders onto the range, they should be greeted with "Cease Fire".





Starting at 10:00 AM, the Top Gun event will be followed by a Long Range Shoot with targets at 100, 125, and 150 yards. Entry fee is \$5. Generally if you do well in the Top Gun you will suck at this event (and vice-versa).
