Merry Christmas & Happy New Year to all, from the Officers and the Board of Directors. We wish each and every one of you good fortune and a healthy year. It's hard to believe that this year is gone. Share with others who are not as fortunate as we are. The Pistol Range is

open and looking great. The 150 yard range and pistol range are two ranges this association can be very proud of having. There are a few rules we need to adhere to on the 150 yard range. **"No Pistol shooting allowed"** on this range. There is no shooting on the **15 & 25 yard line except for sanctioned shoots.** Position 1 & 2 are for **"Prone only"**. Recently incidents have demonstrated we are not reading the safety signs. Pistol shooting will be allowed on the 100 yard range at a minimum of 50 yards or farther. You the members, need to ensure we follow the rules as closely as possible.

A note regarding "Youth members" while on association property. Youth members are 18 through 20 years old. Youth members may have in their possession a rifle or shotgun for use on the range. They may not handle a pistol, unless they are under the direct control of their parent/legal guardian. Exception to this rule is, if said youth member is participating in a sanctioned shoot. The Shoot Chairman then assumes the responsibility for the youth member. Any questions regarding a Youth member and handling pistols, please contact the Chief Range Officer.


Another important issue is releasing the gate combination number to non members. Giving the gate combination to non members, such as neighbors, in-laws, friends or family members who do not have a card issued to them is strictly forbidden. This violation is grounds for disciplinary action, leading to possible termination from the association. Don't give the gate combination to anyone.



Members and Range Officers,

The Holiday Season has started, that means it is once again the time of year to thank our loyal hard working Range Officers. Every active RO will be entered into the drawing for a beautiful Ruger 10-22. The drawing will take place at the December general meeting. The rifle is custom designed with high end parts and assembled by Mr. Ray Bucholz. The more shifts you worked, the more chances you will have to win this very special rifle. The association, its officers and members thank you for your dedicated hard work and long hours to keep our shooting environment safe. Good Luck.

November 15th marked the day for our 2nd "Range Master Review". 41 Range Masters and Shoot Chairs shared ideas and discussed safety situations they have encountered during a range master shift. Many questions were answered and I believe we all have a better understanding of our range rules and how we can approach situations uniformly. Lee Allen developed an Evacuation Plan in the event of an emergency. It will be posted in the meeting hall, on the ranges and a copy is available for RM's in the RSO Box in the meeting hall. We also put together a Range Officer Security/Safety Checklist for RM's to follow. It will also be included in the RSO Box. Thanks Lee. There were questions on Junior and Youth members. A Junior member is under the age of 18. Article III Section 4 of our By-Laws. "A JUNIOR member may not use a rifle or shotgun without the direct supervision of a parent or legal guardian and he/she has completed the hunter safety program. A JUNIOR member may not use a handgun on the range without the direct supervision of a parent or legal guardian and has completed the hunter safety program and has written permission from the parent or guardian". Any person 18 years of age to 21 may become a youth member. Youth members may shoot a pistol, provided they are accompanied by an adult supervisor over the age of 21 and have completed a hunter safety program. No supervision is necessary for a shotgun or rifle. Security must always be an issue on our range and we must all help each other to maintain a secure safe environment. One of the elements of security is checking ID's. Please do not be offended if a range officer stops you on your way in and asks to see your association ID and picture ID. He may also ask which range you're shooting on. We have a very large area to cover and if an RM has a chance to check you coming onto the property, in the interest of time he will do so. Remember you must sign in and out at all ranges you use.

The Range Master Sound-Off is provided for the range officers to "SOUND OFF." Please call me with any information and questions you would like to see appear in the Sound Off. FYI, the 15 and 25 yards lines on the 150 range are for sanctioned events only. Casual shooting is not allowed at either distance.

Remember if we ask the question with the appropriate tone and a friendly attitude we will most likely receive a friendly answer. Range Master of the month is Doug Mitchell- thanks, Doug for all you do.

Keep your powder dry and be safe.
