Hello Everyone,




TAKE YOUR OLD FURNITURE TO THE DUMP

Many of you who shoot on the 150 yard range have noticed that the last three positions on the west side of the range, the lake side, are closed and taped off. This is temporary while the Board of Directors researches several approaches to extending the backstop to the west and raising the backstop the entire length of the berm. The east berm between 150 yard and 100 yard will also be raised on the south east end. We are also placing numbers corresponding to the shooting lane numbers on the outside of the roof so members placing their target frames downrange can see their lane and their shooting position. Shooting out of lanes has become a serious problem and a liability for the Association. Effective immediately, only one target frame per shooting position is permitted during casual shooting. Sorry for the inconvenience, please respect this decision.

Mark your calendar for the December 10th General Meeting. We always have great prizes and lots of fun for all attending. This is the month to donate that special collectable for the table raffle; you know something special that has been in the garage for years, or even something you just went out and purchased. Don't forget to bring an unwrapped toy for Toys for Tots.




