

NRA Metallic Cartridge Reloading Class (1/16/2016)

The holidays are upon us once again...With Thanksgiving and Christmas taking up much of our energies there won't be any class offered for December. Instead, the next class is scheduled for January 16th, 2016. You could have the opportunity to learn reloading techniques that will allow you to produce consistent, accurate ammunition and receive NRA certified reloading instruction in a two session class. The First Part is strictly academic and conducted at the EF&GA meeting hall from 12 – 4 pm. The Second Part will be a "Hands On" reloading bench experience on Elvio's reloading bench. The second session will be scheduled at the 1st session. EF&GA members = \$90; non-members = \$100. 



Sooner or later the Courts (and our Sheriff) will make a decision regarding the issuing of CCWs to us Californians. Contrary to negative comments one hears about how dangerous it is for a citizen to protect himself I ran across an interesting statistic regarding those of us who do have a CCW (crimeresearch.org 02/19/2015). Feel free to pass it on.

Police are incarcerated at a rate of only 0.01% (annual rate) of the general population. CCW permit holders are incarcerated at a rate lower than that of police officers (0.0003% annual rate). Let the doubters chew on that!

Christmas is coming and will be long gone before I have another opportunity wish you all a Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year. If you are able to talk Santa into a new firearm, be sure to break it in properly and learn all about its proper operation. If there is any doubt in your mind, there are a number of classes available through qualified EF&GA instructors. The classes make an excellent gift also for your spouse!

RSOs who are interested in upgrading to an NRA certification, please note that a class is planned for January 30th. You must let me know ASAP if you are interested. In keeping with our Board's decision to be more proactive with respect to lead contamination, we will be making Gloves available at each range. Feel free to use them and teach your youngsters to use them when handling lead or when picking up spent cartridges. We also plan to place eyewash stations at each range. Hopefully, they will not become necessary.

Speaking of lead, at range clean-ups, we will continue removing lead bullets from the pistol range and long gun ranges. The lead will be available to members who wish to make their own bullets and/or fishing weights. It has decent hardness and you can have all you want! Just think of all the money you could save! Invest in a good reloading class and recoup the investment in no time at all. Look at it as being a "green" shooter!

I was able to assist Linda Linaker with her recent "Women on Target" shoot a few weeks ago. Most if not all the coaches were amazed at how well these first time shooters were able to master the basics of shooting. There was no shortage of fifty cent size groups. Anyone who thinks that girls can't shoot better think again! Congratulations ladies.




