



**NMLRA Jr. Grant**

EF&GA was fortunate enough to receive a \$500 grant from the National Muzzle Loading Rifle Association. This grant money will be used to purchase powder and round ball for our Jr. Muzzle Loading program. Thank you NMLRA.

**NRA Metallic Cartridge Reloading Class (1/6/2018)**

Although ammo has plentifully come back to the market, there are California restrictions (Prop. 63) that have been generated to hinder such purchases. The opportunity to learn reloading techniques that will allow you to produce timely, consistent, accurate ammunition while receiving NRA certified reloading instruction is available on Jan 6th, 2018.

The First Part is strictly academic in structure and conducted at the EF&GA meeting hall. This session, 8A.M. on Saturday, Jan 6th, 2018 and will last until approximately 12 noon.

The Second Part is a "Hands On" reloading bench experience. This session generates the practical, detailed experience necessary while you successfully complete a number of your personal reloads.

Scheduling the second session will be at a mutually agreed to time and date. This scheduling will be completed during the 1st session.

The cost is two tiered: EF&GA members = \$100; non-members = \$110. For those individuals beginning and are without any reloading supplies (empty cases, powder, primers, etc...) a \$10 surcharge will be applied. Prior registration and a \$20 deposit is required to secure a place in this class.

**NRA Home Defense class (12/30/2017)**



# RANGEMASTER SOUND OFF

**A**s I am sure you are all aware that many of us play with some rather expensive toys. That being the case, we usually try to hang on to them and justifiably get upset when an item gets left on the range. It could be a firearm or some other piece of equipment such as a scope or you name it. Believe it or not we have been able to recover and return items to their rightful owner. To make things easier on me and our RSOs it certainly helps to report the loss (forgot) as quickly as possible. Also to the greatest extent possible put your name and a phone number on everything possible. It really does help us. If a firearm is left behind, I track it down and take physical possession until the owner can be identified. Other items will usually be secured in one of the RSO lockers until the rightful owner can be found. For example, Mr. Norm Hall, upon reading this might realize that a nice set of electronic ear protectors was left behind. Actually, I called him today to let him know. It certainly helped that he had his name painted on in nice big letters.

The pistol, 100yd and 150yd ranges all have a yellow line behind the firing line. Does everyone know what that line is for? Hold up your hands if you do. Well fancy that, there seems to be several of you not holding up your hand. I suspect that you are the ones some of the RSOs have mentioned recently. So, for your benefit and for those of you who were too embarrassed to keep your hands down, I will explain:

1. When a cease fire is called, clear and safe all fire arms then step behind the yellow line.
2. When there are people down range for any reason, everyone remaining behind must stay behind the yellow line. There is to be no handling of equipment of any kind until the range is again called "Hot". This also means no loading or unloading any equipment from cars.
3. When the range is hot, only the shooter and perhaps a coach should be on the firing line or firing bench. All other guests and/or observers should remain behind the yellow line. Always keep in mind that our safety rules are paramount to the continued existence of this range.

If you have questions feel free to let me know. I will be happy to forward a digital copy of the full Range Manual. It makes great bed-time reading.

# BLACK POWDER NEWS

Hello Again. We had a regular Short Range contest on 10/22/2017. Ren Everett schooled us again on shooting consistently with his 54 Cal Lyman Great Plains Rifle. I gotta get one of those someday. For upcoming events, we have the Dec contest on Dec 24th, Christmas Eve. To pry you out of the house, (and away from all your screaming relatives), I have decided to skip the scheduled Long Range contest and make it a Super Short Range contest instead. Ranges from 25yds to 75yds. This will include a regular pistol contest followed by the rifle contest. It should be quick.

## Practical Black Powder Accuracy Part 4: Patch Lube

From the previous articles on Black Powder accuracy we talked about how to find the best powder charge and patch thickness for your rifle. Now we get into the messy part that can offer the final key to developing the best potential accuracy for your rifle. Patches help form a seal between the round ball and the bore of your rifle. Patches grab both the round ball and the lands/grooves of your rifle to seal off expanding gas from the powder charge designation. It also acts as a guide to keep the ball centered down the barrel as the round ball discharges. How well that works, and how consistent it is from shot to shot is dependent on patch lube.

Patch Lube can be broadly broken into two categories, grease lubes and wet lubes. (I will include Ballistol™ as a wet lube since it is a water-soluble oil.) Grease lubes can be thought of as Crisco, Mink Oil, Wonder Lube, (paste in a tube or tub), and or any other lubricant that is not a liquid at ambient temperatures. Wet lubes can be Hoopes's #9 BP solvent, Frontier BP solvent, Butche's BP Bore Shine solvent, or Wonder Lube 1000 liquid. There are more than I can list here.

All are liquids at normal ambient temperature. I am not saying here that any of the products identified above are better or worse than any other. All of the commercial BP lubes will work. Some will work better than others for your rifle.

Grease Generalities: In my limited experience, grease lubes can be more consistent shot to shot in most rifles that have deep lands and grooves. I have found liquid lubes to be more consistent in rifles with shallow lands and grooves. That's a subjective observation on my part and your mileage may vary. If you doubt it, feel free to conduct your own experiments, and let me know.

# How to place a classified ad in the newsletter

Please help to keep the classified section easy to read and well organized. There is no cost as long as you are an EF&GA member in good standing. Classified ads run for ONE newsletter (one month). If you want to repeat an ad for another month (with price adjustments, etc...) simply re-submit the ad request via e-mail.

Please submit requests for classified ads via email to [newsletter@escondidofishandgame.com](mailto:newsletter@escondidofishandgame.com) and be sure to double-check for spelling and grammar errors.

It may sound obvious but requests for classifieds are frequently received with not enough information to be useful to a reader. **There are 5 main components of a classified ad:**

**Category** – Most classifieds fall into one of 3 categories, 'For Sale', 'Wanted', or 'Lost & Found'.

**Subject/Title** – This will appear in bold in the advertisement. This should be short (2 or 3 words) and concise.

**Description** – This is the body of the advertisement and can be a few sentences but not more than a paragraph. Abbreviations appear cryptic and are not recommended unless they are well known acronyms.

**Price** – A specific dollar amount as well as qualifiers give the reader important information. For example, "\$600 or Best Offer, Buyer pays DROS, Will consider trades"

**Contact Info** – This should be a name AND a phone number (including area code) and/or an e-mail address.

## Oh Deer

Hello. My name is Austin Cote and I'm junior member at the Escondido Fish and Game Association. And I am here to tell you about my experience. To raise awareness of how important the last rule of: TREAT, NEVER, KEEP, KNOW.

In the last week of September, Me, my dad and Rowan, my little brother, went up to the range to sight in a new 22.cal rifle we had purchased. We got there and signed in like normal. But after coming back in from examining our sight in shots, we loaded up, and my finger was on the trigger starting to pull, then out of nowhere Rowan yelled "cease fire. There's a deer on the hill". Me and dad looked at each other and repeated. After all he did say cease fire. So I unloaded my rifle. Put the flag in it. And for the next 15 seconds I was squinting to try and see the deer, but I couldn't see it. Finally, I got up from the bench and I realized the legs of the deer had lined up with the legs of the target stand. ## Black Powder News Continued From Page 7

Grease Pros and Cons: Grease, used realistically, doesn't foul, (wet), your powder charge. Grease doesn't dry out in the bore of your rifle if you're hunting. Grease generally will not dry out once applied to patches on hot days. Grease is generally not acidic and helps protect the bore of your rifle. Grease tends to keep the fouling in your rifle soft from shot to shot for better consistency. You can realistically shoot multiple shots before swabbing the barrel. Grease is period correct authentic..., mostly. (Ignoring "spit patches"). The downside to grease is that it can be very messy to apply, and messy to store treated patches. It can, over a number of shots, (and depending on the product), build up some pretty thick paste like fouling that can be labor intensive to remove. Some of it just plain stinks... (Subjective again. Imagine rancid Crisco burning...)

I am out of space again for this month. I promised the editor I would keep it to one page this time. Next month we can talk about the pros and cons of liquid lube, and how to apply, use, and store, both grease and liquid lubes for your rifle
