Mark's Remarks

I would like to take time to wish everyone a Happy Holiday season and remind everyone to stay safe and drive carefully.

Calendar 101

The first thing I would like to do, is to remind all members to check the calendar **on the website** before heading to the range to make sure things haven't changed. I have had several members, both new and seasoned, ask me questions about things on the calendar like, "If there is nothing on the calendar, can I shoot?" or, "What does [shared] mean?"

Time

The first thing you will see is the **time** (example, 7:30-11:00). This is the time the range is being used for a scheduled event. This includes set-up and take-down. Some events like Combat and Trap/5 Stand require props or machines to be set up. Some events have a safety briefing and if you miss it, you won't be shooting that day. Also, like with trap & 5 stand, don't show up 20-30 minutes before the ending time and expect to shoot more than one round.

Brackets []

The next thing you will find is the **Brackets []**. These hold the location and special information. An example is **[100 – Members & IG]**. This means the event is on the 100 yard range and it is for Members and their Invited Guests only.

An event can be canceled. If an event has been canceled, the word **CANCELED** will appear in the brackets.

If the range location (i.e. Pistol) and the word **SHARED** are together in the brackets, this means there is a sanctioned activity on part of the range, but the rest of the range is still available for casual shooting.

The Bow Hunter Education Certificate does not replace the regular Hunter Education Certificate. Both are required in states that require them. NRA Metallic Cartridge Reloading Class

1/3/2026 (8 am – 12 noon)

Class Description:

This class will supply you with the knowledge of how to properly and safely reload your used casings into economical, effective and accurate ammunition. The class is structured in two separate sessions:

1st session – This class is strictly academic and is held in the EF&GA Meeting Hall on the above dates from 8am until noon.

Hunter Education Follow Up Course 1/11/2026 (7 am - 12 noon)

The online course, alone, is NOT a qualification for a hunter education certificate. Once you have completed an online course, you will still need to attend a 4-hour follow up class with a certified Hunter Education Instructor. Access is permitted to the 4-hour follow-up class only after a student has completed the written Home Study or Online component of the class. To register for a follow up course:

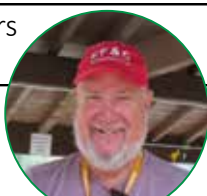

- You are enjoying a beautiful day at the range, standing at the firing line with your firearm loaded, shooting all 10s and Xs and 25 straights. A gaggle of wild turkeys walks out into the line of fire, down range of the firing line. What should you do?
 - Fire a few warning shots over their heads to chase them away.
 - Make loud noises and yell at them until they leave.
 - Declare a CEASE FIRE and make the range cold until they leave.
 - Keep shooting and ignore them.
- After parking your vehicle at the range to be used by the member and guest(s) you must first:
 - Unload your firearms from your vehicle, and uncase them at the firing line and then sign in on the green sheet.
 - Sign in on the green EF&GA sign-in sheet. Then unload your equipment from your vehicle when the range is HOT.
 - Sign in on the green EF&GA sign-in sheet. Then unload your equipment from your vehicle when the range is COLD.
 - Enjoy your time at the range and sign in when it is convenient for you.
- When is it allowed to fire at objects on the ground such as clay birds, cans, bottles, rocks, or gophers?
 - When the range is COLD.
 - When the range is HOT.
 - Anytime when an RSO is not present on the range.
 - It is never allowed to shoot at any object on the ground at any time for any reason.

Cold Range:

- Blue Blinking Lights **ON**
- DO NOT Handle Firearms & Equipment
- Handle Targets
- Sweep Up Brass Behind the Yellow and In Front of the Red Line

OK TO GO DOWN RANGE

Hot Range:

- Blue Blinking Lights **OFF**
- Handle Firearms & Equipment
- OK to Load/Unload Vehicle
- Sweep up brass behind Red Line Only

DO NOT GO DOWN RANGE

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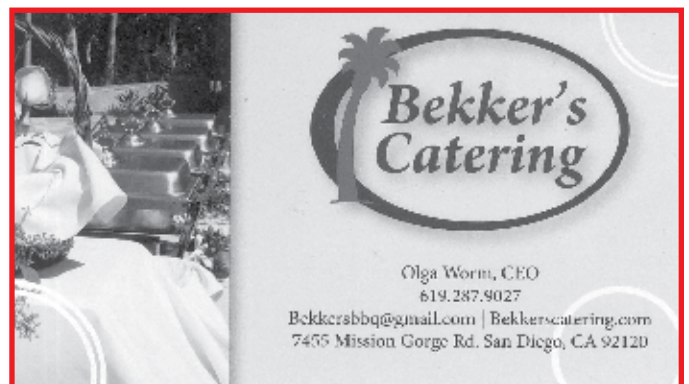

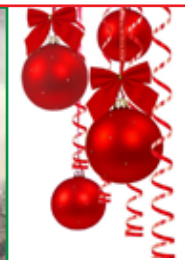

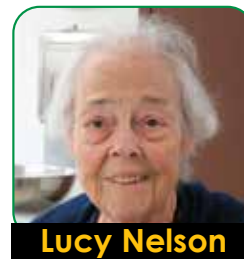
