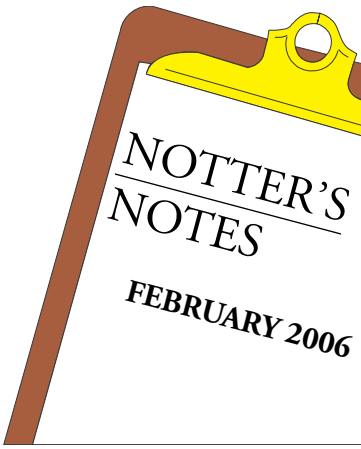

## **IMPROVE YOUR DEFENSIVE PISTOL SKILLS**

Come out to the IDPA Monthly Match. It is the 4th Saturday every month. Sign up is 8:00 a.m. and the match starts soon after. If you want to help set up, show up about 7 AM. We have a lot of fun!

Defensive Pistol matches typically require the use of a service type pistol or revolver of 9mm / .38 special or larger caliber. Shooters competing in Defensive Pistol events use practical handguns and holsters that are suitable for self-defense use. No "competition only" equipment is permitted, since the goal is to test the skill and ability of and individual, not his or her equipment or gamesmanship.

We will set up 4 or 5 stages, where you could be shooting around barricades or barrels, shooting while moving, targets that are moving and engaging multiple targets. Stages are limited to 18 rounds, a minimum of 150 rounds of ammo is needed & two speed loaders or magazines.
