
Membership Renewal


Bow Hunter Education Course



On the 150 yard range, the fire lane is the gravel road from the edge of the concrete to the kiosk where the target frames are stored. Please don't park there.

Muzzle Loading Bullseye on Sunday Feb 1st:

This will be a Short Range Pistol Event held on the 150 yard range. You will shoot at two NRA B-19 targets set at 25 yards. All shooting will be done "off hand", which means "One Handed Duelist style". You will be able to shoot 13 balls at each target with your best ten on each target counting for score.

This event is intended for Single Shot Muzzle Loading Pistols, Flintlock or Percussion, firing patched round balls, using Black Powder (or BP substitute) as a propellant. If you want to participate and have a Cap & Ball revolver, you can shoot in the event. Your score will NOT be counted against the Single Shot Guys.

This is a pretty "Laid Back" event and you DO NOT need the reflexes of a rattlesnake on crack to compete. If you have won one of **Ray's** guns this is a great place to start. If you have the gear, we will take the time to walk you through the event. It is also great practice for the BP Silhouette event next month.

There is a MANDATORY safety briefing at 07:45 and the contest will start promptly at 08:00. The entry fee is \$5 for Association Members and \$10 for Non-Members. Contact **Garth Warner** at 760-420-7550 for more info. Please DO NOT try to use my email address shown in the newsletter, as I am in the middle of installing a new computer and I tend to biff the install at least once.

Muzzle Loading Silhouette on Sunday, Feb 22nd: **CANCELLED!**

This date has been chosen for a Range Clean Up. **Regular BP Silhouette Contests will return starting March 22nd.** This was an event where we shoot steel silhouettes at a variety of distances. For February, we will not be shooting a Standard Short Range rifle course of fire. Rifle targets will not be set at 50, 75 and 100 yards. Preceding the Rifle event we will not hold a Pistol event with targets a 15, 25 and 35 yards.

When we are NOT cancelled, we offer a variety of both Pistol and Rifle classes to compete in. While this event was originally intended for replica Black Powder Muzzle Loading firearms, we have opened up new categories in **Black Powder Metallic Cartridge Revolver and Rifles.** The only restriction is that you need to use cast lead bullets and Black Powder (or BP substitute) propellant.




Happy New Year to all of the Cowboys, Cowgirls, Gamblers and Gunfighters!
