NRA METALLIC COURSE CARTRIDGE RELOADING

Have you been wanting to reload your own but don't know where to start? The opportunity to learn how to reload is going to be available on Saturday, February 9th, 2013 at the EF&GA meeting hall. (This course is a certified NRA reloading course but not sponsored by the EF&GA.) The NRA Metallic Cartridge Reloading Course will be conducted by Elvio Marchi, an Assoc. RSO and an NRA certified instructor. This NRA course will require that all students present their proficiency with a "hands on" session for certification. In order to provide the availability to equipment necessary to accomplish this, the class will be divided into two segments. The academic portion will be held at the meeting hall on the range, but due to equipment logistics, the hands on portion will be held at a separate location on an agreed upon day. The class will be split into smaller groups to facilitate instruction of the "hands on" portion. This portion will be essential to completion of the course...certification

cannot be issued without it. The fee will be \$65 for those individuals that have their own supplies (cases, powder, primers, projectiles and dies. An \$80 fee will be charged for individuals without supplies. Various caliber dies are available for use...check with Elvio on caliber availability. A non-refundable \$20 deposit will be required prior to registration. The class size is limited to 10 individuals. First of all, I would like to congratulate the two lucky Range Safety Officers' that won at the December 2012 General Meeting and Christmas party. This year the prizes were a "Colt" M4 rifle in 22 long rifle won by Harry Fagan and a "Ruger" LC9 handgun won by J. W. Pyles. Congratulations to both.

We had a little clean-up party and invited new members that had voucher hours to fulfill. We raked the broken clays off the trap backstop and cleaned-up the shotgun hulls from the trap field. The party was held Monday evening from 6:00 to 9:00 p.m., 10 Dec. I would like to thank the following new members for stepping up and help clean that part of the range. The new members were: Alonzo Clark,

Randy Jungua, Kay Meyers, Robert Mohn, Mike Moore and Brian Schultz (apologies if I misspelled anyone's name). I think we can all agree that the trap range looked a lot better. We may do this again in the near future, so if you need to fulfill voucher hours, keep a look-out for future scheduled work and dates in the newsletter.

At the December Board of Directors' Meeting, the one year waiting period for new members to become a Range Safety officer was rescinded. If you would like to become a RSO, please contact Mr. Tim Geiser or me at the e-mail listed on the first page of the Association Newsletter.

I really do hate repeating myself, but I find it necessary to do again and include in my Range Safety Tip of the Month.

Targets and Their Placement

On the pistol and rifle ranges, one target centered on the 24 inch by 24 inch target backing recommended - two targets maximum. If using two targets, center them on the 24 inch by 24 inch target backing - **Vertically preferred**. The 24 inch by 24 inch target backing must be at the top of the target frame. Only one target backing is allowed. Check to make sure that bullets will impact the backstop. This can be done by taking aim at the lower target, if two are used, move off the target frame keeping the same horizontal position, shoot one round and see where the bullet impacts. If the bullet does not impact the backstop, do something to make it impact the backstop or do not shoot, please.

The five, seven and ten yard distances on the Pistol Range. Target must be 10 inches square or round maximum (10 inch maximum envelope size for more than one target) and centered on the 24 inch by24 inch target backing cardboard. The target backing must be at the top of the target frame. No silhouettes allowed. Target placement is designed to keep bullets impacting the backstop. Also, check to make sure your bullets make it to the backstop. If you are not going to use the last bay with close range shooting, please set up in another bay

keeping the close in shooting lanes open for those that wish to use them. The rules are posted nearby and all normal range rules apply; i.e., no rapid fire, no draw from a holster, etc.

Setting the target(s) as noted will assure impacting the back stop and keep from hitting the target frame. Please keep paper targets as far from the target frame as possible.

Regarding targets: A single sheet of "paper" that may have multiple bulls-eyes is considered one target. It must conform to the above statements. No political figures or likeness of any person living or dead. **Paper targets only.** As always, if in doubt about targets, check with the on-duty Range Safety Officer/Master.

Return target frames to their designated area when finished with the shooting session.
