BBQ News





NRA/NMLRA BASIC MUZZLELOADING PISTOL CLASS FEB 7

This class is an NRA/NMLRA Certified Basic Muzzleloading Rifle or Pistol Class. Students will learn the basic fundamentals of handling Black Powder as well as the safe handling and use of Muzzleloading Rifles or Pistols to include Flintlock and Caplock. NRA METALLIC CARTRIDGE RELOADING CLASS JAN 3

Start the year reloading your own ammo. Would you like to be shown the hows and whys? Here is an opportunity to receive NRA certified reloading instruction in a two session class. The First Part is strictly academic in structure and conducted at the EF&GA meeting hall. This session, 12:00 on Saturday, January 3rd, 2015 and will last until approximately 4 P.M. The Second Part will be a "Hands On" reloading bench experience. This session takes place at Elvio's reloading bench and generates the practical experience and knowledge necessary in successfully completing your reloads. ope that Santa brought you all the neat "toys" you wanted for Christmas. I also trust that you read all the instructions before you took them up to the range.


A Range Contact Report is a new form developed to keep tract of range incidents that do not require a full "incident report". An example might be a shooter being reminded multiple times that "rapid fire" is not allowed on the EF&GA range. The shooter will be issued a copy and a file copy will be kept. Any questions on the policy can be directed to me at any time.

Over the past several weeks there has been a spate of weapons left on the range. At least two rifles and one pistol that I am aware of. It took a bit of "doing", but all weapons were returned to their right full owners. My gripe is that it took more "doing" than should have been necessary. If find that you left a weapon on the range, report it immediately. Forget about being embarrassed, any of would be, but this is one reason that signing in at a given range is important. It is much easier to track down who was there and when and might have seen your gun. If you are the one that found the gun, report it immediately to me or any board member. Don't wait a couple of days. I guarantee that everyone involved will sleep much easier. In fact this applies to anything left on the range. Scopes can be quite expensive and should be turned over to an RSO asap for secure storage until the proper owner can be located.

First- aid boxes are located at each range and are kept stocked for emergency use. If you have need for a band aid or whatever, feel free to use whatever is required. On the other hand if you are looking for first-aid supplies for your next hunting trip give me a call or send an email. I have a number of sources for inexpensive supplies that I will be happy to share with you.

The range lights are still being misinterpreted so let's try it one more time. The lights are not "COLD RANGE" lights. Obviously there are many situations where a "COLD RANGE" might exist without a need for flashing lights such as a simple cease fire or perhaps there is no one even on the range. However, when anyone is "DOWN RANGE" the lights should be on. At that time no equipment is to be handled other than target preparation. Even if you are the only one on the range I encourage you to use the lights. Someone could drive up while you are down range and might not see you at first. Safety, First, Last and Always.




