Class Description:

This class will supply you with the knowledge of how to properly and safely reload your used casings into economical, effective and accurate ammunition. As you hone your new found reloading knowledge you will also improve your shooting skills.

The class is structured in two separate sessions:

1st session – This class is strictly academic and is held in the EF&GA Meeting Hall on the above dates from 8am until noon.

2nd session – This is "Hands-On" training scheduled with a mutually agreed upon time and date where you will reload your own cartridges on the reloading bench that day.

The cost of the class is \$125 for EF&GA members and \$135 for non-members. If you need supplies (e.g., cases, primers, projectiles and powder) they are available for a \$15 surcharge.

Prior registration is necessary and a \$20 deposit is required to secure a place in this limited class.

Class Description:

The Hunter Education Course is a nationally approved curriculum designed to teach hunters the knowledge, skills and ethics to become safe and responsible hunters. The covered topics include basic firearms nomenclature, safe firearm loading/unloading practices, wildlife conservation, wildlife identification, hunting ethics, hunt preparations, hunting techniques, shot placement, bag limits, tracking skills, basic survival skills, basic navigation skills, basic first aid, game recovery, field dressing, game care and much more. Every state in America requires a Hunter Education Certificate in order to obtain a hunting license. The certificate issued is valid in all states and in numerous foreign countries, and is good for life. No live fire involved, firearms and ammunition are not required for the course.

RANGEMASTER SOUND-OFF

Hello Everyone,

Clean Up your Brass

There have been reports of empty brass being left on the ranges. When you are finished shooting, pick up your empty brass and take it home with you or put it in the orange buckets for recycling.

First Aid Kits

If you need to use one of the First Aid kits, after you are finished make sure the First Aid kit is latched and the combination lock is closed and set to all zeros. The combination to the First Aid kits is the number on your Range ID Badge.

Drawing from Holsters

For casual shooting you are not allowed to draw your handgun from a holster. If you want to draw from a holster, come to a sanctioned event that allows you to do so.

CCW Carriers

CCW licensees are not allowed to walk up to the firing line bench and remove your concealed carry firearm and place a loaded firearm on the bench. If you want to shoot your concealed carry firearm you must transport it from your vehicle in a case and bring it unloaded to the firing line bench. Casual shooting rules apply to everyone.

Guests

Members pay attention to your guests. Each member is allowed two guests. You are responsible for them. Make sure they cooperate with the range rules. The rules are all safety rules and we do not take them lightly.

Unloading Your Gear

Blue Blinking lights on or off applies to all ranges. If the Blue Blinking lights are on do not unload firearms or gear. Sign the Green Sheet and wait for the range to go hot. Then you can unload your firearms and gear.

Green Sheets

YES....This is getting redundant, but it clearly needs to be repeated because Green Sheets are still being turned in without the "Date" and "Range" information filled in. Please fill in that information if it is not already present.

Take Targets Home

All shooters remove your targets from the target backers and return the target frames back to the designated area. TAKE YOUR TARGETS HOME. They can not go in ANY of the trash receptacles at the range due to HAZMAT restrictions.

Cold Range:

- Blue Blinking Lights **ON**
- DO NOT Handle Firearms & Equipment
- Handle Targets
- Sweep Up Brass Behind the Yellow and In Front of the Red Line

OK TO GO DOWN RANGE

Hot Range:

- Blue Blinking Lights **OFF**
- Handle Firearms & Equipment
- OK to Load/Unload Vehicle
- Sweep up brass behind Red Line Only

DO NOT GO DOWN RANGE

Wildlife

2024 Year of the Cross-Stick: Periodically throughout the course of the year we are going to hold Cross-Stick shoots. What is this? You will be given the option of shooting Offhand, or shooting from Cross-Sticks. If you have slightly more brains than a grape, you will shoot from the Cross-Sticks. Cross-Sticks are simply two sticks about 3 feet long, hinged together about 6 inches down from the top to form an X. The crotch of the X, (where you put the forearm of your rifle) is usually covered in leather, felt, or an old rag. You shoot from the sitting position with your rifle setting on the sticks. It is primitive Bench-Rest shooting.

If you choose to shoot Off-Hand while everybody else is shooting from sticks you are welcome to do so. (You will lose.) I will have a small number of Loaner Sticks available for the first few contests. After that you will need to make your own. (This is NOT rocket science.) Two 3' sections of 1x2", a 1/4" bolt, thumb screw, and a few washers can be less than \$10. For those that want a Gucci Stick I can make you one for a little over \$250..... Just get in line.

Percussion Caps: Are becoming more and more difficult to find. Graf and Sons advertised German RWS caps recently. I ordered 5000. Only 250 showed up. Buy them where you can find them and don't hesitate. Even if YOU don't need them, we will find somebody who does.

April Contest: May be cancelled. I am going to be a **First Time Grandpa** towards the end of April. Chances are I will be in Idaho for a couple of weeks. If anybody with RSO or Range Master training wants to run a Silhouette Contest please contact me at gwarner@cox.net before March 15th.
