support. The Board of Directors is a great bunch of guys and will prevent me from going to far a-stray.



### TO: ESCONDIDO FISH AND GAME ASSOCIATION, INC.

I hereby acknowledge that at all times hereafter when I enter upon the property and facilities (the "Property") leased, owned and/or operated by the ESCONDIDO FISH AND GAME ASSOCIATION, INC., a California nonprofit corporation (the "Association"), I shall do so voluntarily. I acknowledge that I am aware that the Association is leasing the real property on which the Association's property and facilities are located, from the City of Escondido, a municipal corporation (the "City"). I further acknowledge that I have been advised and am aware that there is a handgun/pistol firing range, a rifle firing range, a shotgun/'trap' shooting range and an archery range (collectively the "Ranges") on the Property, and that arrows and live ammunition are used and discharged on the Ranges. I have read and am familiar with the rules (the "Rules") for the Ranges published by the Association and agree to fully abide by and adhere to the Rules. I represent and warrant to the Association that I have not previously been barred by the Association from using the Ranges. I hereby waive, disclaim and abandon any right I may now have, or hereafter may acquire or have, to bring any action, lawsuit or other proceeding against the Association or the City by reason of any injury I may incur, or as a result of damage to any property I may own or possess, while on the Property, unless such injury or property damage is caused by the gross negligence or willful misconduct of Association or City. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, I voluntarily assume any and all risks that may be inherent in, exist by reason of, or arise out of the existence of the Ranges on the Property. I further agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Association, the City and their respective successors, assigns, owners, employees, agents, servants, officers, directors, stockholders, shareholders, partners, members, trustees, attorneys, sureties, elected officials and other affiliated personnel (the Association, the City and all such personnel being referred to herein collectively as the "Indemnitees"), from and against any and all liabilities, damages, judgments, costs, fees, expenses, charges, bond premiums, accounting fees, expert fees and attorneys fees, directly or indirectly relating to, or arising out of or by reason of, any act, omission, failure to act, willful misconduct or negligent conduct, whether active or passive, on my part, or on the part of any dependent or guest of mine under the age of 21 years of age, while I or any such dependent or guest is on the Property. I intend to provide the Indemnitees with the broadest possible scope of indemnity and, therefore, I agree that my duty to so indemnify the Indemnitees shall arise regardless of whether willful misconduct or negligence on my part, or on the part of any such dependent or guest, is established, as long as the injury or damage arises out of, or is in any way connected with, my act, omission, or failure to act while I am on the Property. I intend that the Association be the direct recipient and beneficiary of this Agreement and that the other Indemnitees, jointly and severally, be third party beneficiaries of this Agreement. I understand that but for my execution of this Agreement, neither the Association nor the City would allow me or any such dependent or guest to enter upon the Property. This Agreement shall apply on the date hereof and anytime thereafter that I am on the Property. I HAVE READ AND UNDERSTOOD THE TERMS OF THIS AGREEMENT AND AGREE TO BE BOUND BY ITS TERMS.



**Rattlesnake Alert:** With the summer months upon us, we need to be a more vigilant while working and walking around the property. This is rattlesnake season. Please try to stay on the established pathways as much as possible. Remember, at night, the snakes will huddle around rocks and any other objects that have been heated by the sun during the day to keep warm.

There has been poison oak spotted along the perimeter of the property, so please be careful when walking around the tall brush.

Members: Remember, the gate combination has been changed for the new year. Remember to have your new membership card and photo i.d. with you at all times when on the Association property.

Safety: We have observed of late that many of us have forgotten that the handling of **firearms or any equip**-<u>ment</u> while people are down range is strictly forbidden. This is a serious violation of Association safety rules and is non-negotiable. Anytime someone is down range, immediately make your firearm safe and step back behind the yellow safety line with empty hands.

We are aware of the shortage of target frames at the different ranges. We are currently in the process of remedying this condition. Please have a little patience.

While we are on this subject, let's give a huge thanks to Chester Nowicki for supplying the target frames in the past. Unfortunately, Chester can no longer do this service for us. If you or someone you know can do this type of woodwork, please have them contact Ray, Neil or any Board member.

This is the time of the year when the need for more range master hours becomes crucial. Daylight savings time means longer range hours. Please sign up for a post by using the range master schedule sign up books located in the trap ramada first aid box. Just a couple of hours would be an enormous help. Thank you.




