Another thing is that the speed limit on the range is 5 miles an hour. There are two reasons for this. First, we don't raise dust and second, you never know who's going to be stepping out from behind a building. I have also noticed people parking in the fire lanes. These are there for the safety of our members. They are on the 100 yard range and on the 150 yard range. On the 100 yard range it is from the edge of the pad to the trunks of the trees. On the 150 yard range it is from the edge of the pad to the target frame hut.

A few more reminders, when you are done shooting trap whether at an event or shooting on your own, you must take your hulls home with you. The same goes for paper targets from any of the ranges. DO NOT throw them away at the range. If the County comes in and finds them we are subject to heavy fines and the possibility of being shutdown.

All new stainless steel turning target frame holders were recently installed on the pistol range, enabling up to sixteen participants for Precision Pistol (formerly known as Bullseye Pistol) matches. New frames were assembled for both 25 yard and 50 yard distances with bulls at standard height from shooting positions. All firing is done standing in the off-hand (one-handed) position without artificial support. Two 900 point rounds are held on the second Saturday of each month. Participants can utilize .22 rimfire, centerfire handgun, and/or .45 caliber pistol. The new turning target system and frames conform to NRA standards and can host Excellence-In-Competition (EIC) matches sanctioned by the Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP), potentially attracting competitors from throughout the southwestern states. ## Around the Range

### The End of an Era The Final Rendezvous by Garth Warner

June 14th and 15th mark the end of a long series of Muzzle Loading Contests that stretch back over 30 years at the Escondido Fish & Game Association. That Saturday and Sunday were the end of a long tradition for what has been one of the longest running competition events in EF&GA history. Before AR contests, before Combat Handgun, before .22 Cracker Shoots, there was a Rendezvous.

During the high point of the Fur Trade in the 1830s, fur trading companies would schedule a Rendezvous to pick up pelts, and to resupply members of the fur trading companies. Essential items like powder, shot, traps and clothing items were all provided for sale or trade. All manner of manufactured items could be found, that were otherwise not available in the Rocky Mountains in 1830s North America. During the "Rendezvous" there could, and would, be competition between the Mountain Man Trappers. Contests could be rifle or pistol shooting, tomahawk or knife throwing, fire starting and/or virtually anything you could imagine. (Often fueled by excessive amounts of spirited beverages)

Past EF&GA presidents, like **Denny Martin** and **Neil Pisk**, along with a whole host of previous muzzle loading Shoot Chairs and dedicated members like **Ray Bucholz**, kept the Rendezvous competition tradition alive over many years. "Rendezvous" camps would boast 15 to 30 people who would shoot the events during the day and camp out overnight in the campground to repeat the next day.

Sadly, there has been very little "new blood" for a number of years. The gun industry that flooded the market with muzzle loading pistols and rifles for the bicentennial in 1976,, are either no longer in business or have moved on to other more profitable firearm lines. The **Jeremiah Johnson** movie that drove many to buy their first "Hawken" rifle, has faded from memory. Older members, who have been dedicated Muzzle Loading shooters are aging out. A number of these extremely experienced Mountain Men have passed on in just the last few years.

We just completed the last Rendezvous. Turnout was poor, as it has been for several years. You will note that I am not providing who won or lost. The reward for this contest was the experience of the event. As a mark in history, **Jerry Strauss** fired the last round of the last Rendezvous on June 15th 2025. It was a clean hit on the target.

Thank you all who participated over the years to make this the memorable event it was.
