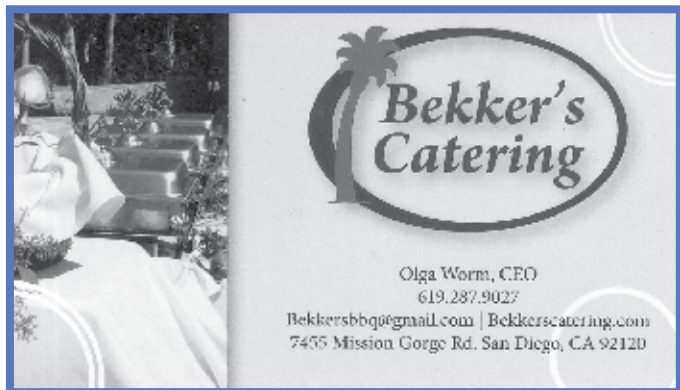
Target Wedges

100 Yard Range Project Update

We are finally on our way!!! In response to some input from members and to jump start the 100 yard range remodel, we have decided to do another design change. We are going to do a complete demo of the existing structure and replace it with a new prefab steel structure 24' x 75'. This will be much quicker and involve less downtime to the range.

If we provide the foundation, the cost of the prefab includes erection. It will only take 3 to 4 days once the foundation is done for the building to be finished! Pending a timeline commitment from the manufacturer, we expect to have the project completed this summer.

The project will be able to be accomplished for the same budget, but it will still require a large volunteer effort. Jack will need volunteers for the demo, footing and slab excavation, forming and epoxy dowels to the new slab and concrete finish. If necessary, we can still hire a crew for just the concrete finish work.

Bow Hunter Education Class

6/10/2023 & 9/9/2023 (7:00 am – 3 pm)

Class Description:

The Bow Hunter Education Course is a nationally approved curriculum designed to teach bow hunters the knowledge, skills and ethics to becoming safe and responsible archery hunters. The covered topics include basic bow and arrow nomenclature, safe bow and arrow carrying practices, distance-judging techniques, wildlife conservation, wildlife identification, hunting ethics, hunt preparations, hunting techniques, tracking skills, shot placement, basic survival skills, basic navigation skills, basic first aid, game recovery, field dressing, game care and much more. Most states in America require a Bow Hunter Education certificate in order to obtain an archery hunting license. The Bow Hunter Education Certificate does not replace the regular Hunter Education Certificate. Both are required in states that require them. The certificate issued is valid in all states requiring it, and is good for life. The Bow Hunter Course includes 3-D archery field shooting at various targets and distances, including using a ground blind and tree stand. Bring a bow, arrows and quiver. Traditional and compound bows are acceptable. Use field tips on the arrows, no broadheads for the course targets.

NRA Basic Shotgun Class

Class Description:

This class covers firearm safety and basic skills of Shotgunning. It is also designed to train the student with the proper skills required to hit a moving target. The NRA Certified Shotgun Course teaches stance, gun ready position, swing to target, trigger pull and follow through. The class consists of classroom exercises and hands on instruction including live fire exercise through which students will learn and demonstrate safe and proper shotgun shooting procedures and technique. Hands on range time will include techniques required for shooting moving targets (Trap). Upon successful class completion students will receive the NRA Basic Shotgun Certificate. 

RANGEMASTER SOUND-OFF

Hello everyone,

Lapses in Safety Protocol Continue to Happen.

When you arrive at the Pistol Range look to see if the Blue Lights are on and Blinking. If the Blue Lights are on and Blinking do not unload firearms or gear. Sign-in on the Green Sheet and wait for the Blue Lights to turn off and the Range to go hot. When you bag or unbag your firearms on the Pistol Range do so on the Firing Line shooting bench. Do not bag or unbag your firearms on the middle tables or rear seating benches. Last month we had people handling firearms on the middle tables pointing the firearm at people that were standing at the Firing Line shooting bench. Members pay attention to your guests. They are your responsibility.

Range Hot and Cold Lights

Blue Blinking lights on or off applies to all ranges. So does bagging and unbagging your firearms and gear. Review the Hot Range/Cold Range box in the lower right corner of this page for guidance.

The Green Sheets

Green Sheets are being turned in with no Date and Range information filled in. If you sign any of the Green Sheets and there is not a Date and Range filled in, Fill in the Date and Range.

Clean Up Your Targets and Target Frames

All shooters remove your targets from the target backers and return the target frames back to the designated area. Do not dispose of used targets at the range. Take them home.

Watch for Wildlife

Watch for Turkeys and Deer on the range. If wildlife appears down range, call a "Cease Fire" until the range is clear. We can not shoot toward the wildlife.

Take Your Guns and Gear Home

Make sure that what you bring with you to the range, you also take back home with you. All of it.

Fur Trapper Rendezvous

What was it? In the 1830s Fur Trapping Companies would schedule a time and location for a "Rendezvous", to allow trappers to resupply items they could not otherwise obtain in the wilderness. This might include Powder, Shot, Clothing Items, Shoes, Food stuffs, Firearms, etc.

It also allowed trappers to hold stimulating conversations with women of negotiable virtue, obtain refreshing homemade beverages, and Oh-Yeah, have impromptu contests for common skills popular at the time. This could include Rifle and Pistol Contests, Hawk & Knife Contests, as well as Archery and Fire Starting events.

We are going to hold our Rendezvous on June 17th and 18th on the 150 yard range and in our campground. Period clothing is strongly encouraged. Primitive camping is available. See the Flyer to the right.
