
## ATTENTION MEMBERS AND GUESTS

# RANGEMASTER SOUND OFF

**All “active” RSOs** should take note and save the date. Why, you say? Well, over seventy years ago on that date a young mother presented her husband with a bouncing baby boy. They named him Tim and of course the rest is history. As it turns out the Board of Directors in their infinite wisdom decided that August 31st is to be set aside as RMAD which stands for Range Master Appreciation Day. There will be more on the subject over the next several months, but basically, it is EF&GA’s way of saying thank you to all the volunteer hours our RSOs put in every year. **Mark the Date!**

**I hate to say it,** but I am starting to think that everyone in our organization does not take my sometimes long winded discourses to heart. Maybe they don’t read them at all, but I did mention just last month that rapid fire is not permitted on the range except in sanctioned events. Nevertheless during a range visit last week I was at the 150 yard range and I heard what sounded like a machine gun on the pistol range. Not being quite as quick as I once was, the “machine gunner” was pulling out as I got there. Ladies and Gentlemen, please read and heed. No rapid fire!!! You must have your firearm under control at all times; not doing so can be detrimental to your membership.

**As you all must know by now,** May 18th is our annual BBQ. It is open to the public, members and guests alike. We shoot, we throw things, and then later on, we eat good food and then win things. We also have a permit to sell beer which has restrictions that must be observed. We cannot sell any alcoholic beverage until all shooting ceases and firearms are secured. Also, **no one is allowed to bring any alcoholic beverages onto EF&GA property.** This is where it becomes Red Shirt responsibility and I am requesting RSO volunteers to assist. We will make certain that everyone is able to participate in the events so don’t worry about missing anything. Send me a quick email with your interest.

**Just a reminder,** one of the duties for an RSO is to check the padlocks on the sheds and gates at the range. They are always combination locks and when a gate or shed is closed the lock should be set to all zeroes. If the last user did not reset them properly, the Duty RSO should see that the locks are reset properly.

**The weather** is finally starting to warm up a bit and among other things that means critters are coming out of their winter hiding. Always keep in mind that tempting as it may be those “critters are not to be used as targets”. Our Range is also a wildlife conservancy and no hunting is allowed. Gophers, squirrels and such can be a bit of a nuisance at times, but just let the rattlesnakes (and other snakes) do their thing. They are allowed to take care of the problem and they will do it just fine. NO, you cannot shoot or otherwise harass the rattlesnakes either!


