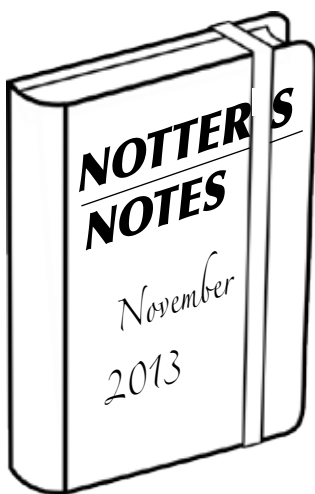

# RANGEMASTER SOUND OFF

## Old Oaks and Old Marines

On a warm afternoon in November a Marine Sgt and his platoon spent a rather unpleasant afternoon in a land far, far away. They were involved in a very nasty firefight and had only a rice paddy dike about two feet wide for protection. "Protection" may not be the best descriptor since high powered projectiles seemed to pass through the earth at will and when they hit you they hurt like crazy. Now fast forward about forty-seven years and place yourself on the EF&GA 150 yard firing line. You are shooting at a target with your high-power center fire rifle at a target downrange and your rounds are impacting about two feet from the top of the berm. The thickness of the berm at that point is only a couple feet thick and guesses what? That berm is protecting some beautiful old California Oaks. If they were to be destroyed by rifle fire the club could easily pay as much as \$90, 0000.00 each to replace them.

So now we have come full circle to a lesson learned forty-seven years ago in a far off land. Two feet of dirt is not enough protection against high-powered rifle fire. SO, if your rounds are impacting the berm too high up, do something about it immediately. Change your target, change your frame, change your position, do whatever is necessary to get more earth between you and those oaks trees. Every member has the responsibility to make sure those oaks are protected. If another member is shooting too high and is not adjusting appropriately then it is your responsibility to let an RSO know about it or even simply remind the shooter that there may be an issue and ask for an adjustment.

Speaking of **High Power**, sometimes no power can be a problem. With some regularity the power goes out in the range area. It may not affect the average member too much unless you drove all the way out there and the electric gate will not open. If an RSO is on duty, he/she has instructions on what to do. Unfortunately, there are occasions when there is no RSO around so what do you do? If you are inside the property, you should pull the pin on the power arm of the gate opener. Drive through and pull the gate shut. You will notice that there is a chain and a combination lock attached to the post. The combination on the lock will be the same as the silver sticker on your badge. Secure the lock and chain around the gate, immediately call me or any board member and you can be on your way. Now, if you are stuck on the outside you have additional options. You can turn around and go home, you can cuss out the power company or you can go through the man-gate using the combination on the silver sticker, then walk in, pull the pin, drive through and secure the gate with the chain and combination lock. The Board in its infinite wisdom has decreed that all gate locks are to be set with the same combination. The combination will change each year, but will match the number on your silver sticker.

OK, so I have imparted enough wisdom for this month.
