California Glock Ban

As our resident FFL, **Patrick Russ** provided an update on the upcoming Glock ban in California. All stores must receive their stock of Glock pistols by January 1st. After July 1, 2026 California will no longer allow the sale of any Glock pistols. The state "contends" that the trigger bar on glocks can be converted to turn the firearm into a fully automatic pistol with something known as a switch. Glocks and Glock parts are already becoming more scarce. You will still be able to own, carry and shoot your Glock pistols.

NRA Metallic Cartridge Reloading Class 11/1/2025 (8 am – 12 noon)

Class Description:

This class will supply you with the knowledge of how to properly and safely reload your used casings into economical, effective and accurate ammunition. The class is structured in two separate sessions:

1st session – This class is strictly academic and is held in the EF&GA Meeting Hall on the above dates from 8am until noon.

2nd session – This is “Hands-On” training scheduled with a mutually agreed upon time and date where you will reload your own cartridges on the reloading bench that day.

Cost: \$125 for EF&GA members and \$135 for non-members. Supplies (e.g., cases, primers, projectiles and powder) are available for a \$15 surcharge if needed.

Prior registration is necessary and a \$20 nonrefundable deposit is required.

Hunter Education Course 11/8/2025 (8 am – 4 pm)

The Hunter Education Course is Nationally approved. Topics include basic firearms nomenclature and safe loading/unloading practices, wildlife identification, hunting ethics, hunt preparations, hunting techniques, shot placement, bag limits, tracking skills, basic survival skills, basic navigation skills, basic first aid, game recovery, field dressing, game care and more. The certificate issued is valid in all states and several foreign countries, and is good for life. No live fire involved.

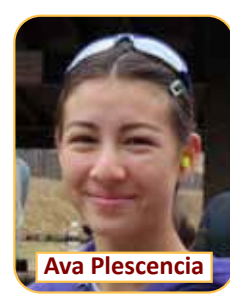

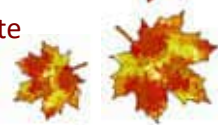
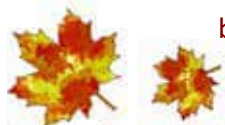

BLACK POWDER NEWS

Return of Muzzle Loading Rifle Fest

Sunday, November 2, 2025

EF&GA 150 yard range, safety meeting at 0745, first event at 0800

Entry fees: members \$5 per event or \$15 for all the day's events

Non-members \$10 per event or \$30 for the day

These events are open only to traditional muzzle loading rifles shooting patched round ball. This is a spirit-of-the-game competition and requires competitors to use equipment relative to the pre-1850 time-period.

Event #1: (0800) **Bench Rest** - The rifle may be loosely supported with only the forearm, no sleds, no pig's eggs. Course of fire is 1 target (A21) at 150 yards, best 10 of 13 shots counted for score. 2 divisions: flintlock and percussion

Event #2: (0900) **Buffalo Harvest Matches** - Course of fire is 1 target (B100) at 125 yards. Total of 5 shots, 2 from the off hand position, 3 from X sticks. All shots count for score. 3 divisions: flintlock, percussion, and traditional Hawken (must pass inspection - see 'What Makes It a Hawken')

Event #3: (0930) **Mike Fink Challenge** - Course of fire is 1 target (human silhouette with whisky jug balanced on his head) 1 shot at 35 yards, closest to center of jug wins. Any shot touching the silhouette is a DQ.

Event #4: (0945) **Shooting the Vee** - Course of fire is 1 target (a vee shaped black target) Closest to the bottom of the open vee without touching the black wins. 1 shot at 25 yards.

Event #5: (1000) **Seneca Run** - a timed event including 5 silhouette targets at various distances, running between targets (approximately 400 yards total), reloading from the bag at each loading zone, sticking a hawk with at least 1 complete turn. Individually timed runs determine the winner - minimum of 5 shots.

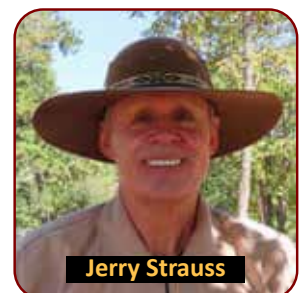

Nobody walked away hungry, and the best part of it was sharing company with friends. **Pam Tucker**, **Ray Bucholz**, his brother (**Ron**) and nephew (**Daniel**), along with the spouses of some of our stalwart SPAR members were all in attendance – it was a good gathering for us old-timers.



Next up was the Hawk and Knife throwing competition and the highlight of that was having **Marc Cederquist** (who is relatively new to this event) throw the top hawk score of the day.

We closed the day with a rousing game of Left-Center-Right. The winner will be donating the pot back to the Association.



It was a fine time for everyone and proves once again that the real measure of a "good" event is not limited to the number of participants. We missed many of our usual suspects who had other commitments and we hope to see them when we renew Old Frontier Day in 2026.

New Signs at the Front Gate

As you enter and leave the property you will see new signs reminding you to wait for the gate to close before you drive away. The signs inside the gate will also remind you that the speed limit within the property is 5 mph. The signs look great. Make sure you follow them.



We are all RSOs

As an Association, we are all responsible for the safe operation of our range. You have three responsibilities:

1. Make sure you know and follow all safety rules.
2. If you witness an unsafe situation or rules violation, politely point out the infraction.
3. If you are the perpetrator, correct the unsafe situation or rules violation WITHOUT AN ATTITUDE.

The proper response is NOT, "Yeh, Yeh, Yeh" or "Who are you?" A proper response is, "Thank You", "Please show me the correct way" or something to that effect.

There are laminated copies of the rules at each range kiosk.

Common Safety Issues

Unloading your gear from the car when the blue lights are flashing.

No one should be handling guns or ammo while the blue lights are on. Someone could be down range. Imagine being down range and looking back to see someone playing with their firearm.

Unloading your firearms from behind the firing line.

Every week someone is observed unloading their firearm at the table behind the yellow line or on the seating benches or even in your car. All three are unsafe. Please take your bag or case to the firing line table or shelf to unpack them. Going forward observed violators will be asked to come before the Board of Directors with consequences.

Parking in the Fire Lanes.

This is particularly problematic at the 100 yard range. There is a Fire Lane between the pad and the CA Oak trees. Don't block the Fire Lane.

New Member Walk Throughs

There are New Member Walk Throughs the third Thursday of every month. During the winter months these Walk Throughs need to begin earlier in the afternoon. To facilitate this, all event and casual shooting must be OFF THE RANGE by 3:00 pm November through February.
