I announced at the last membership meeting that I have been in contact with our new City Real Property Manager, Ann Marcarrelle. She has certainly been a breath of fresh air for me since she is very cooperative and communicative. We should be having our final meeting for approval of the new lease extension as well as the property expansion within the next two weeks. I also announced that we had an inspection from the City's Environmental and Water Resource Departments a couple of weeks ago. Ann assured me, as recently as yesterday, that we are doing fine. However, we must continue to pick up the shotgun wads and mine the lead. Remember, they came through right after we had done this.

The board has decided to contract out the maintenance and janitorial services. Ralph would spend one day a week doing maintenance and Jack would spend four hours a week cleaning the clubhouse. Our accountants are telling us it would be wise and less expensive for us due to tax laws.

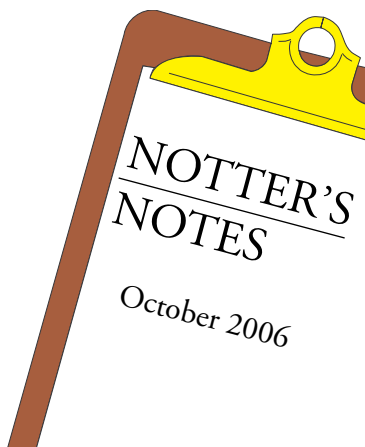
