The shoot consists of 10 people on the firing line and the top score (out of 10 clays) wins a frozen turkey. Ties are resolved by a shoot out. The shoot begins at 8:00 am and continues until all of the frozen turkeys are gone.

Hunter Education Class 10/14/2023 & 11/11/2023 (8 am – 4 pm)

Class Description:

The Hunter Education Course is a nationally approved curriculum designed to teach hunters the knowledge, skills and ethics to become safe and responsible hunters. The covered topics include basic firearms nomenclature, safe firearm loading/unloading practices, wildlife conservation, wildlife identification, hunting ethics, hunt preparations, hunting techniques, shot placement, bag limits, tracking skills, basic survival skills, basic navigation skills, basic first aid, game recovery, field dressing, game care and much more. Every state in America requires a Hunter Education Certificate in order to obtain a hunting license. The certificate issued is valid in all states and in numerous foreign countries, and is good for life. No live fire involved, firearms and ammunition are not required for the course.

NRA Metallic Cartridge Reloading Class 11/4/2023 (8 am - 12 noon)

Need or want ammo but can't find any? MAKE YOUR OWN!

Class Description:

This class will supply you with the knowledge of how to properly and safely reload your used casings into economical, effective and accurate ammunition. As you hone your new found reloading knowledge you will also improve your shooting skills.

The class is structured in two separate sessions:

1st session – This class is strictly academic and is held in the EF&GA Meeting Hall on the above dates from 8am until noon.

2nd session – This is "Hands-On" training scheduled with a mutually agreed upon time and date where you will reload your own cartridges on the reloading bench that day.

The cost of the class is \$125 for EF&GA members and \$135 for non-members. If you need supplies (e.g., cases, primers, projectiles and powder) they are available for a \$15 surcharge.

RANGEMASTER SOUND-OFF

Over the past few months we have had New Member Orientations for a large and eager group of people new to our range. They aren't necessarily new shooters, but new members at this range who need to become accustomed to our rules and regulations. Some have gone blind trying to read all of our signs.

So...We are asking all of you (remember you are all RSOs) to assist our new members and your guests in learning our procedures. If you see them doing something incorrect, please introduce yourself and help them understand how to avoid being in violation.

Let's start with the blinking blue lights. The default state at the range is HOT (lights OFF). It is an exception when the range is COLD (lights ON) and everyone at the range must be cognizant that there is a "Cease Fire". No handling of firearms and equipment. Stand behind the yellow line.

Now let's address unloading your firearms and equipment. When you arrive at the range, ensure that the range is HOT before removing your cased firearms from your vehicle. Nobody likes it when someone is messing with a firearm behind your back. Your firearm should be unloaded from your bag/case on the firing line bench, not the table or benches behind the firing line. Keep the firearm pointed down range. (If you intend to place a rifle on one of the racks, you still need to unload it from its case at the firing line first.) Reverse this process when it is time to load your firearm back into its case. If you are not following these procedures, you are probably "sweeping" other shooters on the range which is a major safety violation.

Finally, remember that we are all RSOs regardless of whether or not you have a Red Hat. If you see another member doing something unsafe, please politely remind them. If that doesn't work, notify the Chief Range Safety Officer or Assistant Chief Range Safety Officer with details at <u>Gfukuda@escondidofishandgame.com</u> or <u>Mbaldwin@escondidofishandgame.com</u>. The Board convenes a special inquisition for those who violate our safety rules.
