Darrin's Dissertation

InterClub Trap Hosted by EF&GA

In the years that I have been blessed with the privilege of serving EF&GA I have been handed the task of running certain events. In most cases it is an exercise in herding cats. At the end of August, I ran the InterClub Trap event, and we had 43 shooters from all over southern California participating in the competition. The 'herding cats' metaphor was accurate in this event as expected but I found myself surrounded by excellent EF&GA Members who stepped up and helped make the day go off without a hitch. **Mark Eller** and **Breen Emery** stepped up to score the eight squads through two rounds of 16-Yard Trap and two rounds of Handicap (distance based on 16-Yard scores). **Mark Baldwin** and **Ron Schroeder** helped with registration, score data-entry, and lunch service. **Randi Michael, Phillip Janikowski**, and many others helped reload the Trap machines after every four games. People came to me and tried to give me credit for such a smooth and excellent event, but I need to publicly state that none of it would have been possible without the volunteers who showed up and helped out. When I speak of these people as volunteers, I mean that I didn't even have to ask anyone to do what they did, they just did it. This is why the InterClub at OUR Range is the most popular of any venue in the region.

Problem Resolution by Members

During the InterClub event, it was brought to my attention that we suddenly had no water pressure anywhere around the Range. After some quick diagnostics and some guesswork, we reset a few circuit breakers and somehow, we had water again. A while later (after the InterClub, during Trap and Pot) we lost and regained water pressure once or twice more. This continued through the weekend and on Sunday, **Jim McKim** (after running the National Match Course and the As-Issued Military Rifle Match events) discovered the same problem. Jim had some background in this sort of equipment, and he worked with **Dean Dorman** (our Maintenance Guy) and a licensed vendor to get the issue resolved ASAP. One of our well pumps lasted much longer than its designed service life and needed to be replaced. Once again, we had an issue, EF&GA Members stepped up, and the problem was solved properly and quickly.

The point that I am making here is that the EF&GA Membership is a different class of people. We take pride in our environment and when we see something that needs to be done, we don't complain about it, we just do it.

Volunteer(s) Needed

In Black Powder Silhouette we currently have 10 Bear Silhouettes. These are roughly 18" tall x 6" wide. They were originally constructed with a 1/4" x 2" x 8" mild steel base. The base on these units ended up being way too light, allowing the silhouettes to fall over in moderate wind. To correct this I obtained 10- 3/4" x 6" x 9" heavy steel plates and welded them onto the existing small bases. While this allowed the Bear Silhouettes to stand upright in the wind, they proved too heavy for the intended purpose. It is now impossible to knock them down if struck by a ball in the lower half of the silhouette (WAY TOO bottom heavy). To rectify this I need a volunteer with a plasma cutter, a cutting torch, or a heavy duty metal cutting band saw, to cut 1" off the front and back of the larger bases. (This will count for your Volunteer Hours if you need them.)

Failing that, I have 10, really heavy, boat anchors that I can make you a deal on.

NRA Metallic Cartridge Reloading Class

10/5/2024 (8:00 am – 12:00 noon)

Ammunition is hard enough to find and expensive enough. Is there any better reason to learn to reload your own ammunition?

Class Description:: This class will supply you with the knowledge of how to properly and safely reload your used casings into economical, effective and accurate ammunition. As you hone your new found reloading knowledge you will also improve your shooting skills.

The class is structured in two separate sessions:

1st session – This class is strictly academic and is held in the EF&GA Meeting Hall on the above dates from 8am until noon.

2nd session – This is “Hands-On” training scheduled with a mutually agreed upon time and date where you will reload your own cartridges on the reloading bench that day.

The cost of the class is \$125 for EF&GA members and \$135 for non-members. If you need supplies (e.g., cases, primers, projectiles and powder) they are available for a \$15 surcharge.

Prior registration is necessary and a \$20 nonrefundable deposit is required to secure a place in this limited class.

Hunter Education Class

Class Description:

The Hunter Education Course is a nationally approved curriculum designed to teach hunters the knowledge, skills and ethics to become safe and responsible hunters. The covered topics include basic firearms nomenclature, safe firearm loading/unloading practices, wildlife conservation, wildlife identification, hunting ethics, hunt preparations, hunting techniques, shot placement, bag limits, tracking skills, basic survival skills, basic navigation skills, basic first aid, game recovery, field dressing, game care and much more. Every state in America requires a Hunter Education Certificate in order to obtain a hunting license. The certificate issued is valid in all states and in numerous foreign countries, and is good for life. No live fire involved, firearms and ammunition are not required for the course.

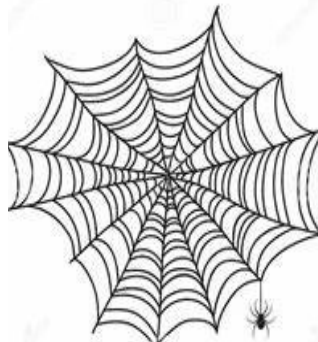



Cost of this class is \$75 for members, \$125 for non-members

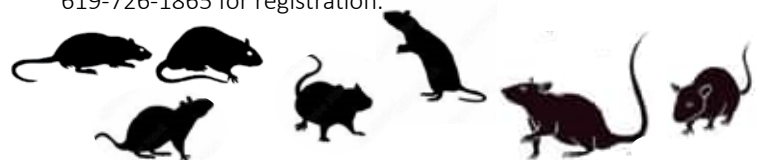

Negligent Discharge



In the event of a negligent discharge, even if there is no injury, a "Cease Fire" must be called immediately. The incident must be reported immediately to the Shoot Chair or RSO on duty. If you are responsible for a negligent discharge, you are not in the right frame of mind to be handling firearms. You will be asked to pack up because you are finished shooting for the day. Come back when you are in better control.

Casual Shooting Rules vs Sanctioned Events

The Casual Shooting Rules are designed to mitigate risk. Members have the luxury of coming out and shooting without direct supervision. Along with that privilege comes a responsibility to keep themselves and other members as safe as possible. For that reason, members are expected to abide by the Casual Shooting Rules. There is a laminated and bound copy of those rules at each kiosk.

At certain Sanctioned Events risk is mitigated in other ways. Shooters' skills are evaluated prior to participation and each shooter is supervised, one on one, by an RSO. That RSO will stop them if they pose a risk.

NRA Certified Firearms Training and Advanced Firearms Handling Events

One of the somewhat unique and valuable functions within our Association is that we provide firearms training to our members and the community. We have a team of nine NRA certified instructors who maintain a high level of personal liability insurance. A significant bonus to the Association is that a percentage of the revenue for these classes goes back to the Association for use of the facility. The biggest expense for the class is the training materials from the NRA and County. EF&GA also has opportunities for advanced firearms handling skills through several sanctioned events, such as Combat Match, AR-15 Match, Sheepdog Training and Defensive Pistol. At the same time we must maintain a safe environment for our casual shooters. That, of course, requires that the rules are stricter for casual shooting than for these more advanced firearms handling experiences. The Casual Shooting Rules are designed to mitigate risk. We all know that holster drawing and rapid fire are not allowed during casual shooting, for example. Why then, are they permitted at sanctioned events?

Sanctioned Events have exceptions because we attempt to mitigate risk in other ways. First, the shooter is checked out. Their skill level must meet the requirements before they are approved to participate in the event. There is also an RSO standing right off the shooter's shoulder. The arrangement is one RSO for every shooter, watching your every move and ready to stop you if you pose a danger. That obviously doesn't happen in casual shooting. So, hopefully, everyone can appreciate the differences. Come out and join the experiences if you choose.

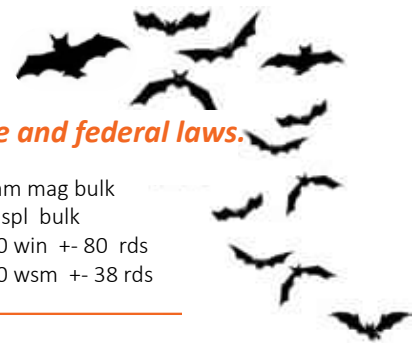
