Mark's Remarks

Check **WEBSITE** Calendar Before You Come



One of the things I try to tell new members and seasoned members alike is to always check the calendar on the website before driving up to the range. Often things can change from the printed calendar (in the middle of the newsletter). This is because the calendar in the newsletter is sent to the publisher about two weeks prior to the newsletter coming out. Examples of this are CCW classes, skill builder classes or even events or classes being canceled.

I have had instructors tell me that they have had members come up to them and say that their class wasn't on the calendar. They were looking at the newsletter calendar. Don't go to the newsletter calendar. It could be out of date. Instead go to the website, www.escondidofishandgame.com. Scroll down until you find the event calendar. If the date number has a dash under it, it means there is something scheduled for that day. You can click on the date and it will bring up a box with what is scheduled for that day. Or, you can go to the blue box labeled "Full Event Calendar" and it will bring up a fully updated calendar.

To avoid this confusion, this month in the center of the newsletter, instead of the calendar we are going to have a list of the regularly scheduled events by day of the week. You will still need to go to the calendar to make sure the event is still going on or if things have been added. Now, however, there is only **ONE** calendar.

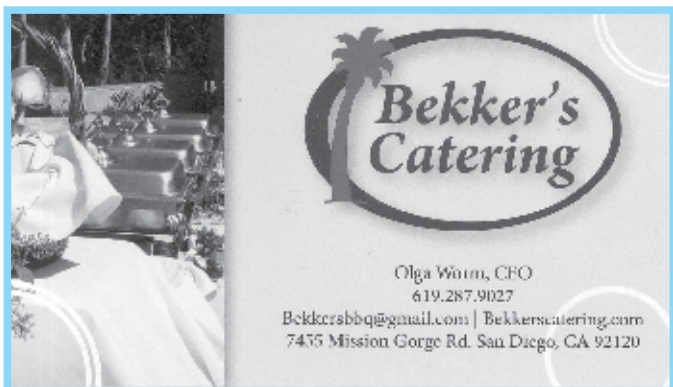


By-Laws Review

Sheepdog CCW Skill Builder is Back

Beginning on the fourth Saturday of this month and each month thereafter (except Nov. which will be on Friday the 28th) we will relaunch the CCW Sheepdog Shoot. If you are a California CCW holder and are looking for a comprehensive means and outlet for regular training in carrying a concealed firearm (in this case, a handgun, either pistol or revolver) consider this shoot a monthly opportunity to familiarize yourself with the skills and mindset necessary to responsibly, capably and confidently carry on a regular basis. Becoming qualified to carry should only be the beginning of consistently training in the way you carry and may have to deploy your firearm in a self-defense situation. Handgun carry and competent day to day management and potential deployment of that firearm is a specialized and diminishing skill which atrophies or fades over time if not practiced and maintained. If you have made the decision to invest in the responsibility of carrying a concealed handgun, you must also discipline yourself to train and practice with that firearm in the manner you would use it, together with the mindset and situational awareness it demands. The personal liability attached to this authorization is tremendous, and it is incumbent upon all who receive it to manage it safely. Join this group of men and women who understand the discipline of every day carry and work together to keep each other sharp, aware, responsible and mindful of what it's about. Then join us for a safe and satisfying morning of legal updates, spirited discussions, and skill-building live fire drills that will help build the kind of confidence and understanding you need to carry competently. *Shoot Chair, Herb Smith*

BLACK POWDER NEWS - OLD FRONTIER DAY

Sunday, October 5, 2025 at the Escondido Fish and Game Range in Escondido, California

This event is a celebration of the early American frontier and we welcome everyone to come out for a full day of fun or for a part of the day, participating in those events that interest you. We encourage frontier dress but it is not required. This day is brought to you by the members of the Society of Primitive America Riflemen (SPAR). This day of activities is being offered as a fun experience in the spirit of our frontier heritage, and this is our trial run. If the event has support during this trial period, it will be offered again in the future. We hope you can join us.

Firearm events will take place on the 150 range. We will set up everything else in the campground. Start time is 0800. Lunch will be Noon (ish) in the campground. Medallions (bag tags) will be presented to the winners of both the pistol and rifle divisions at the conclusion of the appropriate aggregate. Other awards may be available according to the number of entrants.

At 0800 on the 150 yard range – **The Pistol Aggregate**
5 shots standing with 1 handed grip @ 25 yards on target B19*
5 shots standing with 2 handed grip @ 50 yards on target B19*
5 shots standing with 2 hands @ 25 yards on target B19
5 shots standing with 1 handed grip, snap shooting (5 seconds time limit) on command @ approx. 15 yards on target B19
The total aggregate score will determine placing. There will be 2 divisions, single shot muzzle loader and black powder revolver. All pistols require open iron sights and must shoot round ball projectiles. Targets marked with an asterisk (*) will be used to determine SPAR muzzle loading champions. The entry fee is \$5 for EF&GA members and \$10 for non-members.

At 1000 (or immediately following the pistol aggregate) on the 150 yard range – **The Rifle Aggregate**
5 shots standing @ 50 yards on target B100*
5 shots standing @ 100 yards on target B100*
5 shots bench rest @ 100 yards on target B100
5 shots standing, snap shots (5 seconds time limit) on command @ approx. 35 yards on target B100
The total aggregate score will determine placing. There will be 2 divisions, flintlock and percussion. All rifles must be open iron sights and shooting patched round ball. Targets marked with an asterisk (*) will determine SPAR Champions. The cost to enter is \$5 for EF&GA members or \$10 for non-members.

At 1200 in the campgrounds – **Lunch**. SPAR Members will offer hamburgers and hot dogs to all participants. We invite you to peruse our displays and ask SPAR members questions about our organization.

At 1300 in the campgrounds – **Hawk and Knife** (open to all entrants, no additional entry fee required)
Each competitor will have 10 throws with both hawk and knife. All throws require at least 1 full turn, and must meet or exceed minimum distance standards (18 feet for hawk, 14 feet for knife). SPAR scoring will be used, 1 point for a stick, 3 points for a stick in the designated bulls eye, 0 points for a non-stick. If you do not own a hawk or knife, we will have some you can use during the event.

At 1400 in the campgrounds – **Left-Center-Right**, a game of chance (entry requires 5 x \$1 bills) This is a favorite game of our SPAR campers and it requires NO SKILL AT ALL. Someone playing for his/her first time is just as likely to win as someone who has played this game for years. The game will be explained completely to all who choose to play. All money used to enter play is added to the pot, and the winner walks away with it all. So if we get 10 players, someone will walk away with 50 x \$1 bills!!!

We are looking for **Maximum Turnout** for this event. You will NOT need to enter ALL of the categories to participate.

This is a FULL DAY event. We are looking at providing pot luck. We will need someone to step up and take this challenge once we know how many people to expect. My wife will provide Lasagna, paper plates, and plastic utensils. We will need non-alcoholic drinks, salad, (yech), and chips/potato salad etc.

So...You want to be a Junior Rifle Coach?

(Part Two)

Adjusting Micrometer Sights and/or “Which Way is Left?”

by Garth Warner



Every Junior Rifle in the Association’s Inventory has some form of precision adjustable rear sight. To the very best of our ability, ALL the sights are zeroed for 15 yards. Almost ALL of the sights have **SET SCREWS** to lock the adjustable knobs in place to **HOLD** the zero.

Junior Coaches are strongly encouraged **NOT TO TRY TO ADJUST THE SIGHTS**. If a coach thinks they need to adjust the sights they are instructed to notify the active range master for the event. He, in turn, will contact the armory to send a man over with a screw driver to loosen the set screw and adjust the sights as needed. Turning the adjustment screws with the set screws locked down results in no sight movement, stripped threads and broken parts. Replacing the rear sights runs about \$80 each as the small internal parts that break are frequently not available for replacement. So, let’s say you have a rifle somebody adjusted **BEFORE** it was issued to your shooter. You contact the Range Master, who sends somebody from the armory over to loosen the set screws. The guy from the armory seems to think you can walk and chew gum at the same time, so he makes an adjustment. He then tells you he left the set screws loose so you can fine tune the adjustment as needed for your shooter. What do you do now? Which way is Up?

This is the easy part for a rear adjustable sight. To move the POI (Point Of Impact) up, you move the sight up. To move it down you move the sight down. To move the POI left, you move the sight left. To move the POI right you move the sight to the right. Easy Right?

But how much do you move the sight? Here it gets a little trickier. Different sight manufacturers set up their sights for different “Click” adjustment distances. One click in elevation may equal 1/2”, 1/4”, or 1/8” of movement at 100 yards. While the sights should have an indicator arrow printed on the sight to indicate up/down, right/left, they generally don’t say what “One Click” equals in movement. Just to confuse you, we are shooting at 15 yards, not 100 yards.

For the sake of Junior Rifle, let’s assume ALL of the sights have an adjustment that results in one click equals 1/2” at 100 yards. So let’s do the math... To move the POI 1/2” at 100 yards would be ONE click. To move the POI 1/2” at 50 yards would be TWO clicks. To move the POI 1/2” at 25 yards would be FOUR clicks. **BUT WAIT! THERE’S MORE!!!!** We are shooting at 15 yards, so maybe add another click or two. As a **RULE OF THUMB**, because you don’t know how much the sight adjustment will move the POI at 15 yards, **ONLY MOVE THE SIGHT HALF** of the calculated distance. Have the shooter shoot a sighting shot and adjust from there. The most important part is to Tell the Armory Guys that the sight has been loosened and adjusted. They will then tighten down the set screws before the next shooter is issued the rifle.

All of the above seems relatively simple right? At every event we end up with rifles that have the sights broken because somebody forced the adjustment without releasing the set screws. We have had rifles returned with the sights “adjusted” to the stops UP/DOWN and OFF the Stops LEFT/RIGHT. We average 3 broken sight sets per year. Even if the sight is NOT broken, the guys in the Armory spend their lunch break sighting in 3 to 5 rifles that coaches have “Adjusted” incorrectly. Don’t do it. Ask the Range Master for help and we can make it work.

Now. Since this diatribe is in the Black Powder section of the newsletter, “What does all this have to do with Black Powder firearms?” you ask. Well some black powder rifles or pistols have rear adjustable sights, but not all. Most often, the Muzzle Loading rifle will have a fixed non-adjustable rear sight. Under the best of circumstances the rear sight is “drift” adjustable with a brass rod and a tap hammer. Muzzle Loading Black Powder guys are more likely to make sighting adjustments with the front sight. Using a brass drift rod and a tap hammer, the front sight is moved Left to move the bullet impact to the Right, or hammered Right to move the bullet impact to the Left. Elevation is increased by filing down the front sight until you are “ON” at whatever range you choose to zero your rifle “with a specific powder load”. To RAISE your POI you need to add powder and/or buy a new taller front sight. (You can’t put the metal back once you file it off). The upside to the black powder sight issue is that a new front sight is \$10 to \$12 bucks. You file it to fit your front dovetail and you’re good to go. Most guys have a parts bag with new and used sights. The one you filed down too far, may fit another rifle, someday, somewhere, somehow.....

Feel free to disagree with any of the above. I will be the grumpy old man in the Junior Rifle Armory trying to put the broken sights back together again.....

Muzzle Loading Bullseye Two Gun Dog Days of Summer Event

Another hot one at the range on Sunday, Sept. 7. Our group is at low numbers due to senior medical issues. Sucks to get old. This was scheduled as a 3 gun event, but only one guy showed up with a Trade Gun. We will call it a Two Gun Dog Days of Summer Event (Rifle and Pistol). Targets were NRA B-19’s at 50 yards for rifle and B-19s at 25 yards for Pistol. Pistol was “Duelist Style” one handed.

Black Powder Silhouette Oct 26th: This will be standard short range with rifle targets at 50, 75 and 100 yards. Pistol targets are always 15, 25 and 35 yards. Firearm classifications for this event are as follows:

Open Rifle: Any Muzzle Loading rifle using any sights, firing a patched round ball, using black powder, or black powder substitute.

Primitive Rifle: Any Muzzle Loading rifle using fixed iron sights, firing a patched round ball, using black powder or black powder substitute. All loading and reloading is done from the bag.

Master Rifle: Only previous Top Gun Winners and/or individuals that have shot a possible are eligible in this category. Any Muzzle Loading rifle using fixed iron sights, firing a patched round ball, using black powder, or black powder substitute.

BPCR (Black Powder Cartridge Rifle): Any original or replica black powder cartridge rifle, using any sights, firing conical lead bullets (NOT JACKETED), using black powder, or black powder substitute.

Single Shot Pistol: Any single shot Muzzle Loading pistol using any sights, firing a patched round ball, using black powder, or black powder substitute.

Cap & Ball Revolver: Any cap & ball revolver, using any sights, firing a round ball, using black powder, or black powder substitute.

NEW CATEGORY!!!!!!!!!!

Single Action Cartridge Revolver: Any single action cartridge revolver, with any sights, firing a conical lead bullet (NOT JACKETED), using black powder, or black powder substitute. (This category is for the Cowboy Action guys and gals that want to shoot more than 10 feet.)

Note that entry for this event is a whole \$1. The kicker is that you need to load heavy enough to knock over a steel silhouette out to 35 yards. Come over to the **DARK SIDE** and enjoy shooting steel that falls down when you shoot it. It can be addictive. (BTW, you can wear cowboy duds or not. We don't care.)
