

RANGEMASTER SOUND OFF

On Saturday, 23 July, we hosted the “JAKES” event put on by the “National Wild Turkey Federation”. We had 62 young people with parents or grandparents accompanying them to the range. They learned firearm safety and how to shoot. They learned about turkey, turkey calling and wild life management. They learned fire starting with flint and steel as well as how to throw a tomahawk and archery. They shot black powder rifles (it is great fun to see a little girl that barely makes it to the top of the handicap pistol bench shoot a black powder rifle and listen to her squeals of delight). They shot a .22 caliber rifle and a couple of clay targets on the trap field. If I missed an event, I do apologize.

We had a great turn out of EF&GA members that helped run events and act as Range Safety Officers. The following, in no particular order with our Range Safety Officers’ indicated by an “*”: *Ed ‘Smitty’ Smith, *Mike Tombrinck, *Bill Williams, *Neil Pisk, *Don Jackson,

On Sunday, 31 July, we held an NRA RSO Certification class for our newer RSO’s. The class was taught, again, by Frank Alessio with some help from Smitty and myself. The class lasted most of the day and everyone learned a lot about range safety and security, different types of firearms, ammunition and powders and passed the NRA Certification test. Please welcome and give a thank you to our newest NRA Certified RSO’s: (in no particular order) Mike Walsh, George Healey, John Schlack, Jay Powers and Dan Orsburn.

On Sunday, 18 September, EF&GA will host its annual Range Master Appreciation Day, RMAD. Again this year, the event is open to Active Duty Range Safety Officers’ only and by invitation only. Invitations will be going out by the beginning of September and remember to bring your invitation with you on RMAD. This year we will be doing things a little differently which should make for a more interesting and fun day. We will have tomahawk throw, black powder rifle, .22 cal. rifle, horse shoe tossing, fishing, and trap. The events will be challenging and hopefully fun. We will keep score and the winner(s) will receive a nice little prize. We will again honor the individuals that will be named Range Officer of the Year and Chief Range Safety Officer.

Beginning Tuesday, 16 August (a late entry), we will be having First Aid/ CPR training for our Active Duty Range Safety Officers’. Marshall Goddard will instruct the certification classes. Marshall is a certified instructor and has been training folks for a long time. Marshall will tailor the course to our needs at the range; specifically, gunshot wounds (let’s all pray that never, never happens) and stabilization until professional help arrives. The classes are scheduled for weekday evenings and a couple of weekend days. They will be approximately four hours in duration and we hope interesting, educational and fun.

Range Safety Tip Of The Month. For the next few months if events allow, I will be “borrowing” the NRA safety fundamentals from the “NRA Firearms Sourcebook”. Rule number one: **ALWAYS keep the gun pointed in a safe direction.** This is the primary rule of gun safety. A Safe Direction means that the gun is pointed so that even if it were to fire, it would not cause injury or damage. The key to this rule is to control where the muzzle is pointed at all times. Common sense dictates safest direction, depending upon the circumstances.
