
indicator) "flags" are a simple and inexpensive way to assure that your firearms are safe before you venture downrange.



# RANGEMASTER SOUND OFF

Livery month as I struggle to write this column, the question is always the same. What is the membership interested in and how can I best pass on useful information. In truth, most of the folks probably do not realize that the original intent of this page was to be a forum for the membership to sound off. So keep that in mind. My RSOs frequently pass on info that I attempt to incorporate whenever appropriate. Any member, who has an issue to discuss, please send it to me. I will do my best to pass it on to the rest of you in my inimitable award winning style. (OK I haven't won an award yet, but surely it is only a matter of time)


As you may remember, I have been on a fire safety binge lately. It has been for good reason and now the County of San Diego is getting into the action too. Section 33.101.5 has been declared enforceable by the Board of Supervisors which effectively prohibits shooting during "high fire hazard" situations. Look it up or contact me. It primarily applies to casual shooting within the County with specific exceptions. Fortunately, EF&GA falls within the exceptions, but check the County Regulatory Code carefully before doing any casual shooting outside of the specified exceptions.

**Camp fires** can be a problem. Even in approved fire rings, fires can still be a hazard, especially during "Red Flag" days. The EF&G BOD has decided that during "Red Flag" conditions only charcoal briquettes should be used in our campground fire rings. AND fires should **always** be attended.

**Question of the day:** Which ranges allow silhouette targets and where are they prohibited.......Hint: Look carefully at the new target visuals posted at each range......Time is up. If you say only the short pistol range you are correct! However, remember that the overall target size must still fit within the 24"x24" target backing. This applies to zombie targets also. (Zombies may not bear any resemblance to me or any other recognizable individual)

There is a 1500 member cap on EF&GA membership. Many of the current members such as me are older than dirt. We may also be retired and able to take advantage of the range during the week when range usage is low. Unfortunately midweek usage can be a problem for younger members who work and have families to support. The longer hours in summer help somewhat and the BOD has decided to open the trap range to casual shooters when events such as Bulls Eye Pistol are running. The trap range will be called COLD by the **Event Shoot Chair** when necessary to change targets. An additional limitation is that clay birds can only be launched by the machine. Hand thrown clays will not be permitted. Feel free to check with me or the duty RSO if there are any questions.


