Darrin's Dissertation

We had a great group of people at the Work Party last month and we got a lot of work done. At these events we do a lot of maintenance tasks as well as infrastructure improvement tasks. By keeping up with the common maintenance tasks, the Range looks clean and tidy as well as keeping any potential brushfire fuel under control. The Improvements are designed to make casual shooting as well as sanctioned events safe, efficient, and fun.

We cleared brush for fire prevention, raked up broken clays (and a few unbroken ones that were probably mine) for general cleanliness and appearance. We finished and tested the plumbing for the new air compressor that feeds the target-turner on the Pistol Range as well as all three Trap machine bunkers. Speaking of the Trap bunkers, we now have nice diamond-plate doors on all three of the bunkers. We also sanded and refinished the shooting benches on the Pistol Range. There were many other tasks that were completed in and around the Meeting Hall and the big shed as well.

We have had a lot of positive feedback about the Steel Targets on the 100-Yard Range. We are continuing to fine tune the structure and **Dave Robertson** and **Gary Fukuda** are doing a great job of executing the improvements. Our current plan is to move the structure further into the hillside to contain any splatter as well as improve the support of the structure. This will put the targets at about 115 Yards from the benches. If we continue to have no safety issues and positive feedback, the next step will be to double the width of the structure so that half of the 100 Yard Range will be for steel targets. When you use the steel targets for casual shooting, only use the two benches (4 positions) at the West side of the structure to prevent crossfire issues. Please continue to be vigilant to make sure that we don't have anyone shooting steel projectiles at the steel targets.

Sept 5th Traditional Archery:


This will be a Field Course in the campground. Bring extra arrows and your metal detectors.



NRA BASIC METALLIC CARTRIDGE RELOADING COURSE

9/25/2021, 10/2/2021, 11/6/2021, 12/4/2021 (1st Session 8 am – Noon)

Class Description: Need or want ammo but can't find any and mailing is not an option? You're left with an old American skill; self-sufficiency and creativity...Make your own! This class will supply you with the knowledge of how to properly and safely reload your used casings into economical, effective and accurate ammunition. As you hone your reloading knowledge you will also improve your shooting skills.

The class is structured in two sessions:

1st session – This class is strictly academic and is held in the EF&GA Meeting Hall from 8 AM until noon.

2nd session – This is "Hands On" Training held at the reloading bench scheduled for a mutually agreed upon time and date. You will reload your own cartridges and produce ammunition that day.

Rangemaster Appreciation Day

One of the events that I have the pleasure to organize is called RMAD (Range Master Appreciation Day). It is my opportunity as the CRSO (Chief Range Safety Officer) to thank the Rangemasters, Shoot Chairs, Instructors and other invited guests for their volunteer work.

Since this is an invitation only event I usually succeed in making someone unhappy that they did not get an invite.

There is a difference between a Rangemaster and an RSO (Range Safety Officer). A Rangemaster is also an RSO, but their job is to manage the entire range not just a specific shooting event. They are here to manage any shooting activity happening on the range, including other RSOs and Shoot Chairs as necessary. The association has a lot of RSOs and I thank them very much for their service, but it is the few Rangemasters that take on the most responsibilities (and should be issued Tasers). They are the individuals I like to recognize at RMAD. One such individual, *Michael Lasiter* has been an outstanding Rangemaster at our Association for many years and has been selected as the *"Rangemaster of the Year"*! Please congratulate Michael the next time you see him at the range.

When is "Sunset" on our range and you need to stop shooting?

There is the published time on our Website and some believe it is when the Sun is below the tree line. Both answers may be correct depending on the time of year.

In the Fall/Winter months the Sun sets early and the shadows are across the 150 rifle range around 4-4:30. In the Spring/Summer it is light until 7:30-8:00+ and you have more shooting time. When dusk is approaching and the shadows are moving across the range it is time to stop shooting.

Spirit of the Game

In Cowboy action (one of our organized shoots) we have something called the "Spirit of the Game" and it has two definitions; one is a complement and the other is a 30 second penalty. Some of the things that will get you that penalty are:

- Willfully shooting a stage other than the way it was intended in order to gain a competitive advantage.
- Shooting ammunition that does not meet the power factor/ minimum velocity.
- Willfully refusing to make an attempt to complete any non-shooting procedure written within the stage instructions.

Members Only are allowed to submit Classified advertisements. Your Membership Number must be included with any advertisement request so that we can properly vet the submission before it is published. The Membership Number will NOT appear in the advertisement. Your Membership Number is on your membership badge on the same side as your photo.

No Illegal Transactions may be advertised in this newsletter. It is now illegal to sell ammunition in California without either going through an FFL or a licensed ammunition reseller. EF&GA cannot facilitate any illegal commerce of a state regulated commodity. This is also why firearm sales should include a phrase similar to Buyer pays DROS when advertising the sale of a firearm.

It may sound obvious but requests for classifieds are frequently received with not enough information to be useful to a reader.

There are 5 main components of a classified ad:

Category – Most classifieds fall into one of 3 categories, 'For Sale', 'Wanted', or 'Lost & Found'.

Subject/Title – This will appear in bold in the advertisement. This should be short (2 or 3 words) and concise.

Description – This is the body of the advertisement and can be a few sentences but not more than a paragraph. Abbreviations appear cryptic and are not recommended unless they are well known acronyms.

Price – A specific dollar amount as well as qualifiers give the reader important information. For example, "\$600 or Best Offer, Buyer pays DROS, Will consider trades"

Contact Info – This should be a name AND a phone number (including area code) and/or an e-mail address.


