The May shoot at EF&GA was cancelled in lieu of the California SASS State Championships held at the Route 66 Shooting Sports Club on April 30th through May 2nd.

There were 132 shooters registered to shoot in the near perfect weather. The first day of shooting included the Wild Bunch Match using a 1911 and an 1897 shotgun. Only 22 shooters chose to shoot this match. The match was won by **Fredrick Jackson Turner**, who also happened to be the only clean shooter of the group. **Double Diamond** placed 3rd, with just one single miss.
